FIRST ANNUAL REPORT OF THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES
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INTRODUCTION

1. This report is submitted to the European Parliament following its Resolution of 16 December 1981 on the Community's anti-dumping activities(1). As this is the Commission's first annual report to the Parliament on the Community's anti-dumping and anti-subsidy activities, information is provided in respect of the years 1980 and 1981 in addition to that given for 1982. The report thus covers the period since the entry into force of the Community's new basic legislation in this area(2). This period coincides with the time during which the current GATT Anti-dumping and Subsidies and Countervailing Codes (3) have been in operation. The Community is a Party to these Codes.

ANTI-DUMPING AND ANTI-SUBSIDY INVESTIGATIONS

2. A summary of the Community's anti-dumping and anti-subsidy investigations initiated, in progress and terminated in the years 1980 to 1982 is given in Table 1 below, and details of the individual actions taken on these are provided in annexes to this report. In order to achieve as great a degree of transparency as possible in its procedures, it is the Commission's practice to publish full details of the allegations of dumping, or subsidisation and injury contained in the complaint. These are given in the notices of initiation which are published in the Official Journal. Similarly, the Decisions, Regulations and Recommendations which terminated the investigations set out all the issues of fact and law which were considered to be material in the investigation and give full reasons for the action taken. These instruments are also published in the Official Journal.

3. It will be seen from the above table that there was an increase in the number of investigations initiated in 1982 compared with the previous years, the number being 20 per cent higher than in 1981 and more than double the number initiated in 1980. Details of the investigations initiated in each year are given in Annex A.

4. Table 1 also gives the number of investigations terminated in each of the years, and provides a breakdown according to the reasons for the termination. There was a sharp increase in the number of investigations terminated in 1982, compared with 1981, though the number was less than in 1980, which was an exceptional year when the number was influenced by a high proportion of terminations at the beginning of the year. These consisted, in part, of complicated investigations which had been initiated in 1978 and 1979 and of investigations which had been initiated in the 1978 steel crisis and left open as a precautionary measure.

IMPOSITION OF PROVISIONAL DUTIES

5. In its Resolution on the Community's anti-dumping activities, the Parliament took the view that once a preliminary determination had been made that dumping and injury had taken place, then provisional duties should be imposed, unless the exporter offered a satisfactory price undertaking. This is the approach currently adopted by the Commission with the result that 18 provisional duties were imposed during the investigations in 1982, compared with 10 in 1981 and 7 in 1980. Details of the provisional duties imposed are given in Annex B.

IMPOSITION OF DEFINITIVE DUTIES

6. Table 1 shows that there was little variation in the number of definitive duties imposed in the years 1980 to 1982, 7 duties being imposed in 1982 compared with 10 in 1981 and 8 in 1980. Details of the definitive duties imposed in each year are given in Annex C.

ACCEPTANCE OF PRICE UNDERTAKINGS

7. The Community is impartial in its stance on the acceptance of price undertakings as an alternative to the imposition of duties. Indeed, it is often found that undertakings prove to be more flexible than duties as a means of eliminating the injury caused by dumping or subsidization. Thus, 35 investigations were terminated by the acceptance of price undertakings in 1982 compared with 7 in 1981 and 46 in 1980. It is the Commission's practice to accept undertakings only after a final determination has been made that dumping or subsidization has caused injury to a Community industry. This practice enables action to be taken expeditiously if the price undertaking is subsequently violated or withdrawn. Details of the investigations terminated by the acceptance of price undertakings are given in Annex D.

INVESTIGATIONS TERMINATED WITHOUT THE APPLICATION OF PROTECTIVE MEASURES

8. The investigations shown in Table 1 which did not result in the application of anti-dumping or countervailing measures during the three year period were those where the termination was due to changes in the market situation, or where no dumping or subsidization or injury was found, or where the investigation was terminated for other reasons. Details of these terminations are given in Annexes E to I. The investigations terminated because of changes in the market situation were those which were initiated and virtually completed under prior Community legislation. The type of change to which they refer is that which resulted in the exporter raising his prices over a considerable period to levels which eliminated the margins of dumping without giving a formal price undertaking.

It has not been the Community's practice to terminate an investigation on these grounds since its current anti-dumping and countervailing legislation entered into force. In all other cases the Decisions terminating the investigations give full reasons for the action taken and, where appropriate, set out the material facts and issues of law. The investigation terminated for 'other reasons' in 1981 concerned imports from Greece. The investigation was terminated automatically following Greece's accession to the Community.

BREAKDOWN OF INVESTIGATIONS BY COUNTRY OF EXPORT AND BY PRODUCT

9. Annex J gives a break down of the 131 investigations initiated in 1980 to 1982 according to country of export. During the period, investigations were initiated on exports from 32 countries, the highest number concerning exports from the USA (21 investigations) followed by Czechoslovakia (13), the GDR (12) and Brazil (9). On the other hand, for exports from 15 of the 32 countries only one investigation was held.

10. The investigations in the three year period are also broken down by product classification in Annex K. It will be seen from the Annex that in each of the years more than 40 per cent of the investigations concerned exports of chemicals and allied products to the Community. Also, whereas in 1980 and 1981 a substantial number of investigations concerned products for the mechanical engineering sector, in 1982 there was a swing instead to investigations concerning exports to the Community of iron and steel products and of other metals.

LENGTH OF INVESTIGATIONS

11. In its Resolution, the Parliament urged the Commission to simplify the procedure for presenting complaints and in particular to accelerate

their response to them. While the Commission naturally makes every endeavour to shorten the investigation time, there are many factors which cause delays. In the first place, it has to be remembered that the investigations by their very nature are complex affairs, requiring visits to be made to the premises of the Community producers and importers of the product in question in order to obtain and verify data, as well as visits to the exporters in the foreign country for the same purpose. There is also an obligation under the GATT Codes to afford all interested parties an ample opportunity to make representations, both orally and in writing, during the course of the investigation and equity demands that they be allowed a reasonable time for this purpose. In addition, account has to be taken of the particular characteristics of the decision making process provided for under the Community's legislation in this field, including the need to consult the advisory committee on the results obtained and the measures considered to be most appropriate to remedy any injury caused. Finally, there is also a need to produce the Regulations, Recommendations and Decisions in all Community languages before they enter into effect. In spite of these factors, however, there has been a reduction in the average time taken to complete a normal investigation from 9.6 months in 1980 to 8.7 months in the last six months of 1982, the average being more or less in line with the average times taken by some of our major trading partners.

12. Notwithstanding the unavoidable procedural delays, the Commission has made some progress in speeding up its response to complaints. In the first place, steps have been taken to impose a provisional duty more quickly where a preliminary determination of the existence of dumping or subsidization and injury has been made. Thus, in the investigations initiated in 1982, the average time taken to impose provisional duties, where required, was reduced to 4.3 months compared with a period of 7.5 months for the investigations initiated in 1980.

13. The second way in which the Commission has speeded up its response to complaints is by achieving a marked decrease in the number of investigations in progress for more than a year. Community legislation provides that the investigations should normally be concluded within a year, and this is the maximum period laid down in the GATT Codes, except in special circumstances. By making determined efforts to reduce the time taken to deal with exceptionally complicated cases, it has been possible to reduce the number of investigations terminated after more than a year from 32 in 1980 to 7 in 1982.

14. REVIEWS

In accordance with the GATT Codes, there is an obligation under Community law to review, where warranted, the Regulations and Recommendations imposing provisional or definitive duties and the Decisions to accept price undertakings. The number of reviews opened, in progress and terminated in the years 1980 to 1982 is given in Table 2.

15. The table shows marked increases in the number of reviews opened in 1981 and 1982, the increasing trend being predictable in view of the rise in the anti-dumping and countervailing measures applied in recent years. It is expected that the number of reviews required will rise substantially in the future as more measures enter into force. Details of the reviews opened in the period are given in Annex L.
16. Table 2 also gives the total number of reviews terminated each year, together with a break-down according to the outcome, and the number of provisional duties imposed. As a result of the reviews, 5 national anti-dumping duties were repealed. These had originally been imposed by Member States under the transitional provisions of their Act of Accession. In addition, one review resulted in the imposition of a definitive duty, while in other cases the measures in force were amended, where appropriate. Details of the provisional duties imposed during the reviews are given in Annex M and details of the reviews terminated in the period are given in Annex N.

AMENDMENT OF BASIC LEGISLATION

17. The Community's basic anti-dumping and countervailing legislation was amended on three occasions during the period 1980-1982.

These amendments changed the Community's procedures for the review of anti-dumping or countervailing measures in force to provide for a minimum period of a year before reviews are held at the request of an interested party. The amendments reflect the wishes of Parliament, as expressed in its Resolution, and were considered necessary, in any event, to avoid the abuse of Community procedures and resources, bearing in mind that measures are only applied after costly and time-consuming investigations in which full opportunity is given for all parties to make their views known. The amendment does not prevent the Commission from carrying out a review at any time, either on its own initiative or at the request of a Member State.

18. In addition:

Commission Recommendation No 3018/79/ECSC was further
amended by Commission Recommendation No 3025/82/ECSC
of 12 November 1982(2)

The purpose of the amendment is two-fold. In the first place, it provides clarification of the methods to be used when establishing the normal value within the basic price system for iron and steel products. This change is designed to take account of an understanding on the application of basic prices which has recently been adopted by the GATT Committee on Anti-dumping Practices(3). In the second place, the amendment enables the Commission to impose anti-dumping or countervailing duties by means of a Decision rather than a Recommendation. This enables the measure to be applied directly in all Member States and avoids the delay and unnecessary administrative inconvenience which arises when the duty is imposed by a Recommendation.

CASES BROUGHT BEFORE THE COURT OF JUSTICE

During 1981 and 1982, seven cases were brought before the Court of Justice and these are given in Annex O. The trend in the Community is towards an increase in litigation and the issue common to all cases on which judgment has been made, or is awaited, is admissibility. The first judgment on this issue has been in the Alusuisse case where the court held that an action by unrelated importers in the Community, requesting the Court to declare void an act of the Council imposing anti-dumping measures, was inadmissible on the grounds that the Council Regulation concerned was not of direct and individual concern to the importers. The remaining cases presently before the Court are likely to settle the issues of the admissibility of an appeal by complainants on both the question of the initiation of an anti-subsidy proceeding (FEDIOL), and the Commission's choice of market economy country when determining normal value (Timex). In the joint cases, Allied and Kaiser, the court has been asked to decide on the admissibility of an appeal on the imposition of provisional measures and the admissibility of an action raised by exporters on whom anti-dumping duties have been imposed.
