
#### COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES



Recommendation for a regulation (EEC) of the Council on the system for guaranteeing the stabilization of earnings from certain commodities exported by the ACP States and the overseas countries and territories associated with the Community and repealing Regulation (EEC) No. 158/76

(submitted to the Council by the Commission)

#### EXPLANATORY NOTE

Article 16 of the Lomé Convention forsees the putting into action of a system designed to guarantée the stabilization of earnings for certain exports of raw materials from the ACP States to the Community as listed in Article 17 of the Convention.

Council Decision (EEC) No 76/568 of 29 June 1976 concerning the association of the overseas countries and territories with the European Economic Community extended the system of stabilizing export earning to the overseas countries and territories.

ACP-EEC Council of Ministers Decision No 3 of 14 April 1977 introduced new products into the system.

In addition certain texts the adoption of which was envisaged by Council Regulation (EEC) No 158/68 of 20 January 1976 have in the meantime been introduced.

Therefore it seems sensible to list the ACP countries and overseas countries affected.

the Member States send details of actual imports to the services of the Commission.

This is the subject of the annexed recommendation for a Regulation, needed to replace Council Regulation (EEC) No 158/76 of 20 January 1976.

Recommendation for a Regulation (EEC) No /77 of on the system for guaranteeing the stabilization of earnings from certain commodities exported by the ACP States and the overseas countries and territories associated with the Community and repealing Regulation (EEC) No 158/76

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community, and in particular Article 213 thereof,

Having regard to the recommendation from the Commission,

Whereas Article 17 of the ACP-CEE Convention of Lomé signed on 28 February 1975 (1) establishes the list of products covered by the system of stabilization of export earnings of the ACP States;

Whereas by Council Decision 76/568/EEC of 29 June 1976 on the association of the overseas countries and territories with the European Economic Community (2) the Council extended the system of stabilization of export earnings to the said countries and territories;

Whereas Council Regulation (EEC) No 158/76 of 20 January 1976 on the system for guaranteeing the stabilization of earnings from certain commodities exported by the ACP States and the overseas countries and territories associated with the Community (3), provides for the sending by the Member States to the Commission of statements of imports of the products covered by the system of stabilization of export earnings;

Whereas ACP-EEC Council of Ministers Decision No 3 of 14 April 1977 has amended the list set out in Article 17 of the Lomé Convention;

Whereas the ACP States and the countries and territories covered by the system of stabilization of export earnings should be listed;

Whereas Regulation (EEC) No 158/76 should consequently be replaced by this Figulation.

AS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION :

#### Article 1

Before the end of each month, Member States shall forward to the Commission a statement of imports during the previous month of the products listed in Annex I to this Regulation:

- from the ACP States (listed in Annex II),
- from the countries and territories (listed in Annex III).

#### Article 2

The statement referred to in Article 1 shall give details of all products:

- which are released for home use in the Member State concerned,
- which are brought under the inward processing arrangements there in order to be processed.

### Article 3

The statement referred to in Article 1 shall show the country of origin of the products, according to the common geographical code in force, the quantities imported and the cif values of these imports, in the national currencies of the Member States.

### Article 4

Regulation (EEC) No 158/76 is hereby repealed.

### Article 5

This Regulation shall enter into force in the third day following its publication in the Official Journal of the European Communities.

It shall apply into effect from 1 January 1977.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
