COUNCIL DECISION

approving the exchange of letters between the Community and the ACP States concerning Annex XL to the Fourth ACP-EC Convention relating to the Joint Declaration on agricultural products referred to in Article 168(2)(a)(ii)

(presented by the Commission)

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

The Final Act of the Agreement amending the Fourth ACP-EC Lomé Convention signed in Mauritius on 4 November 1995 states that Annex XL to the Convention concerning the Joint Declaration relating to agricultural products referred to in Article 168(2)(a)(ii)will be replaced by the text of paragraph 81.

However, in its present form the text will have to be adapted to take account of the results of the Uruguay Round negotiations which has been transposed into the Common Customs Tariff adopted by the Community. The Community has undertaken to revise Annex XL signed in Mauritius and has consulted the ACP States on this matter over the last few months.

The ACP-EC Council of Ministers in Mauritius adopted the recommendation by the Committee of Ambassadors to formally adopt the revised version in the form of an exchange of letters between the Presidents of the EU and ACP Councils respectively.

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN UNION,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Community, and in particular Article 113 thereof,

Having regard to the proposal from the Commission,

Whereas the exchange of letters between the Community and the ACP States on Annex XL to the Fourth ACP-EC Convention relating to the Joint Declaration on agricultural products referred to in Article 168(2)(a)(ii) should be approved,

HAS DECIDED AS FOLLOWS:

Article 1

The exchange of letters between the Community and the ACP States on Annex XL to the Fourth ACP-EC Convention relating to the Joint Declaration on agricultural products referred to in Article 168(2)(a)(ii) is hereby approved on behalf of the European Community. The text of the exchange of letters is attached to this Decision.

Article 2

The President of the Council shall notify the ACP States of this exchange of letters on behalf of the European Community.

ANNEX XL

Joint declaration concerning agricultural products referred to in Article 168(2)(a)(ii)

The Contracting Parties have taken note that the Community intends to take the measures mentioned in the Annex, and which are laid down at the date of signing of the Convention, with a view to granting ACP States the preferential treatment provided for in Article 168(2)(a)(ii), for certain agricultural and processed products.

They have taken note that the Community declares that it will take all the measures required to ensure that the corresponding agricultural regulations are adopted in good time and that, wherever possible, they come into force at the same time as the interim arrangements which will be introduced after the signing of the agreement amending the fourth ACP-EC Convention.


