Having regard to the Opinion of the European Parliament (2),

Considering that the European Council, preoccupied by the continuing
growth in tensions in Central America, agreed in its session of 29 and
30 March 1982 that the aid granted by the Community for the development
of the countries of Central America and the Caribbean should be
increased.
