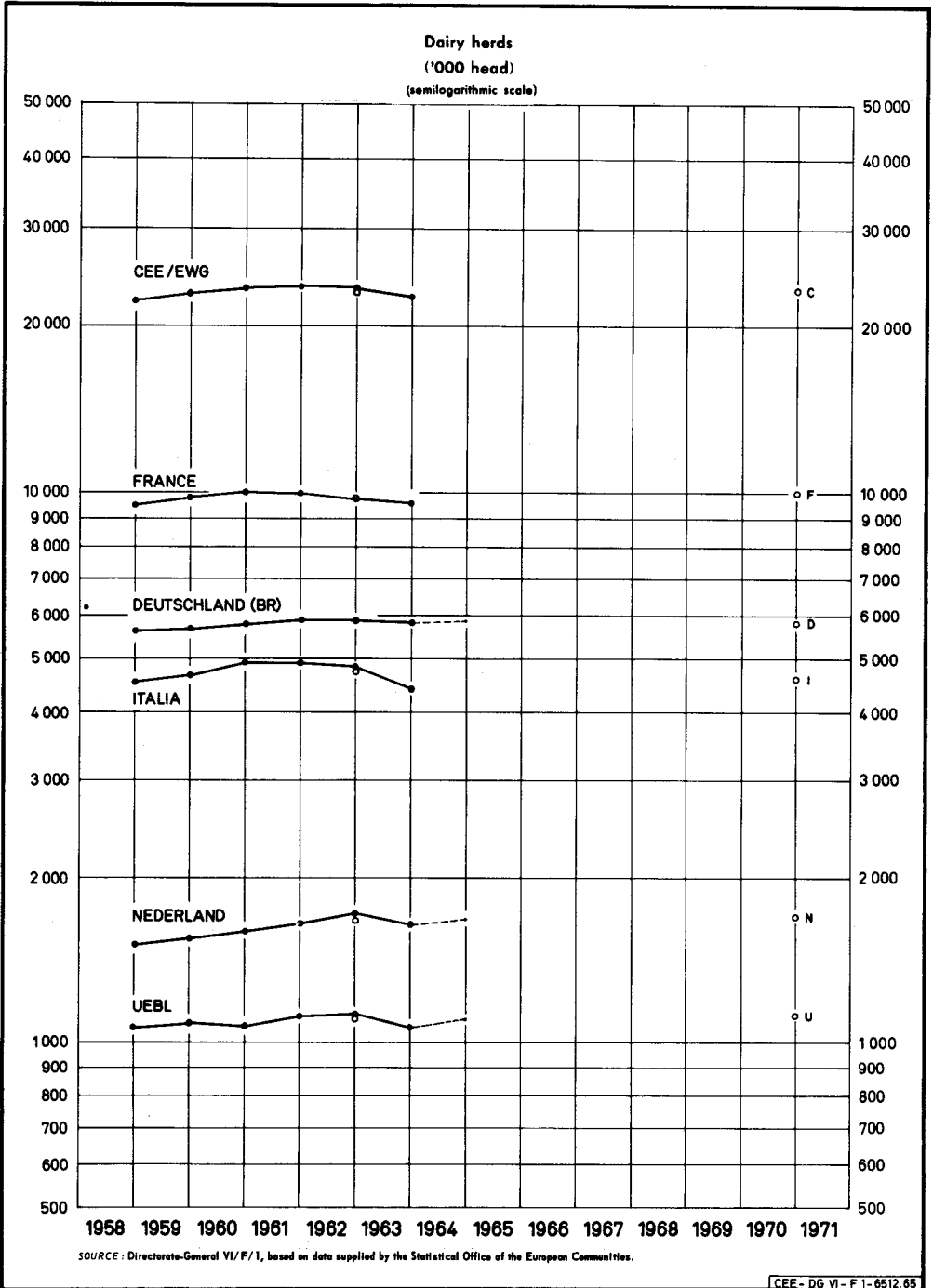

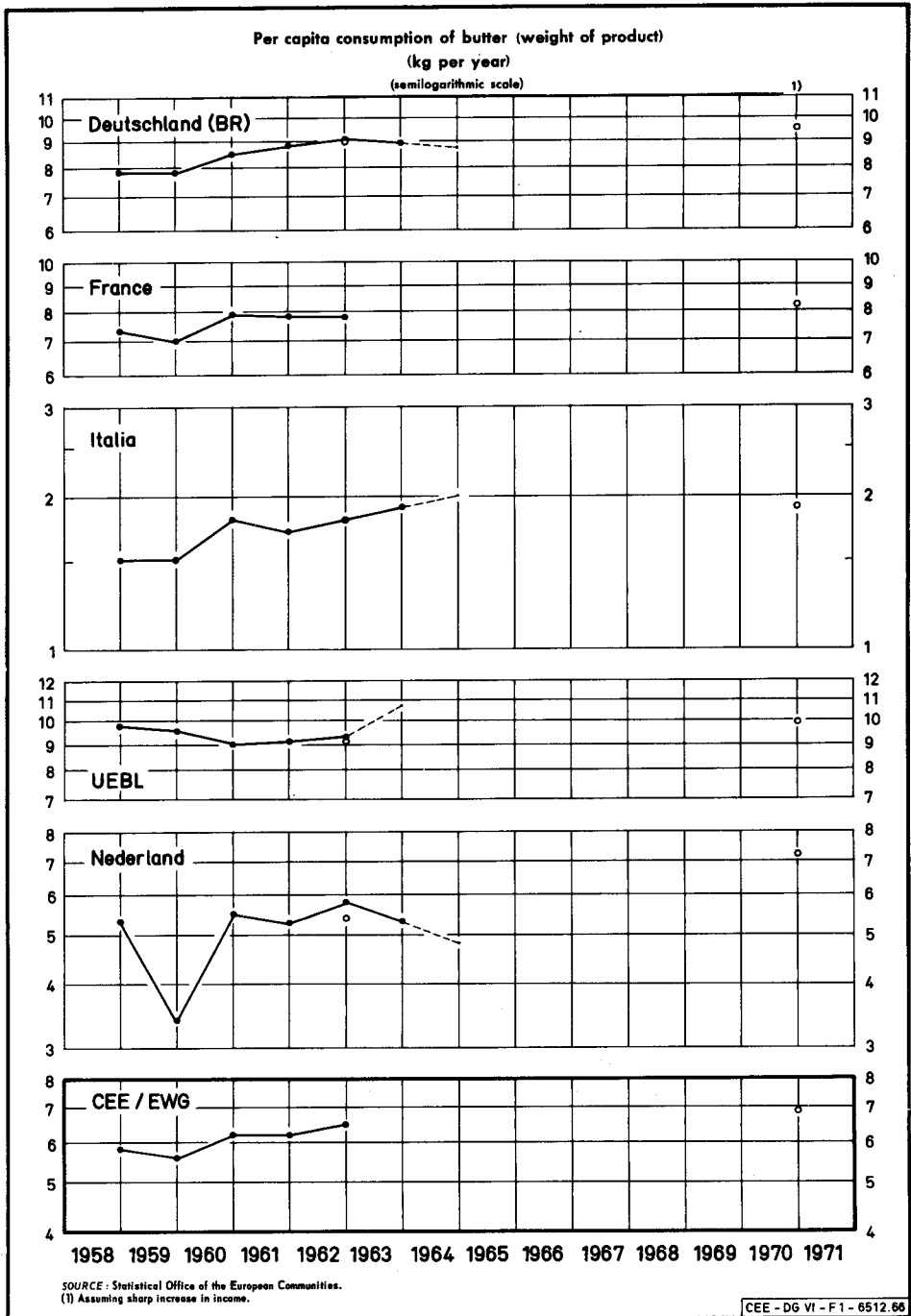

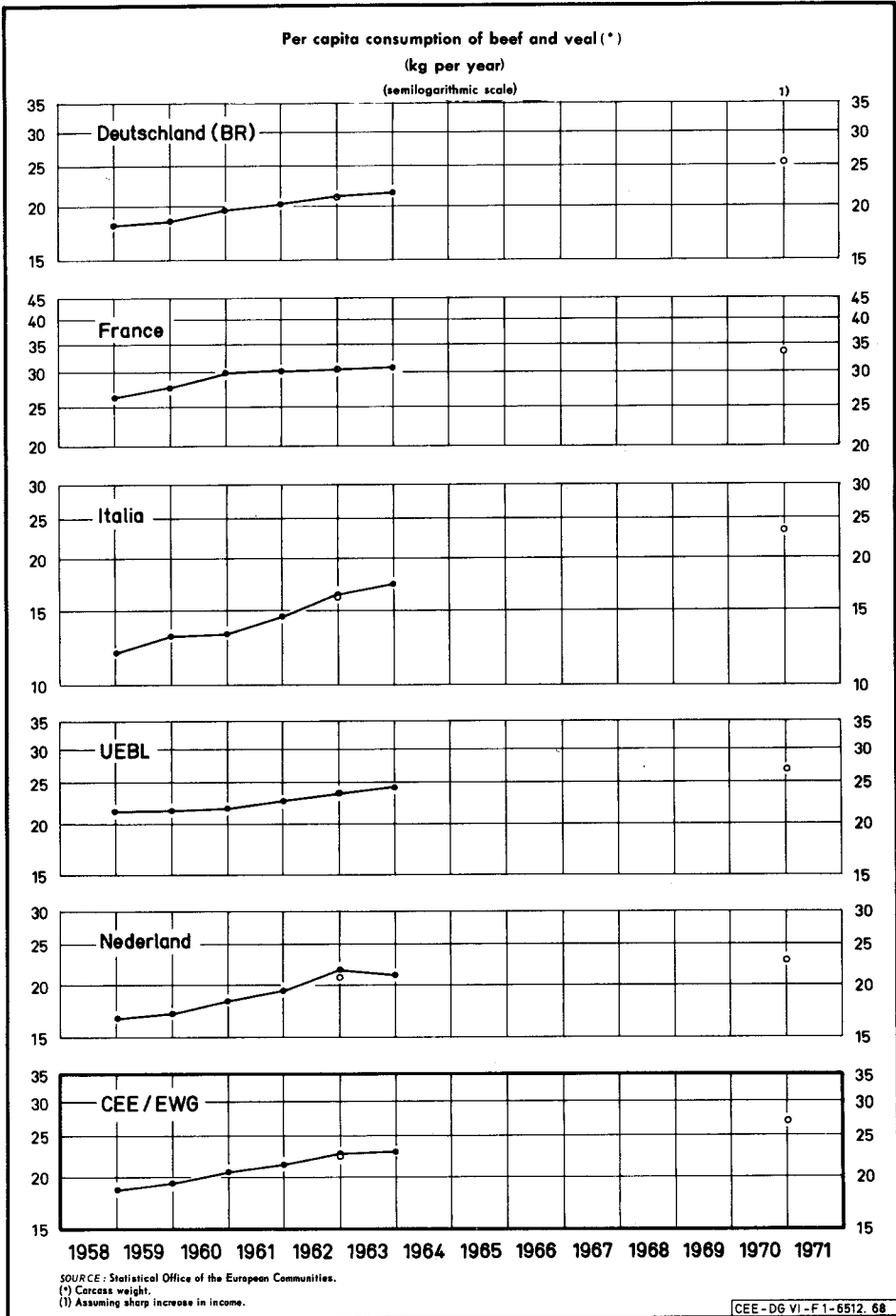

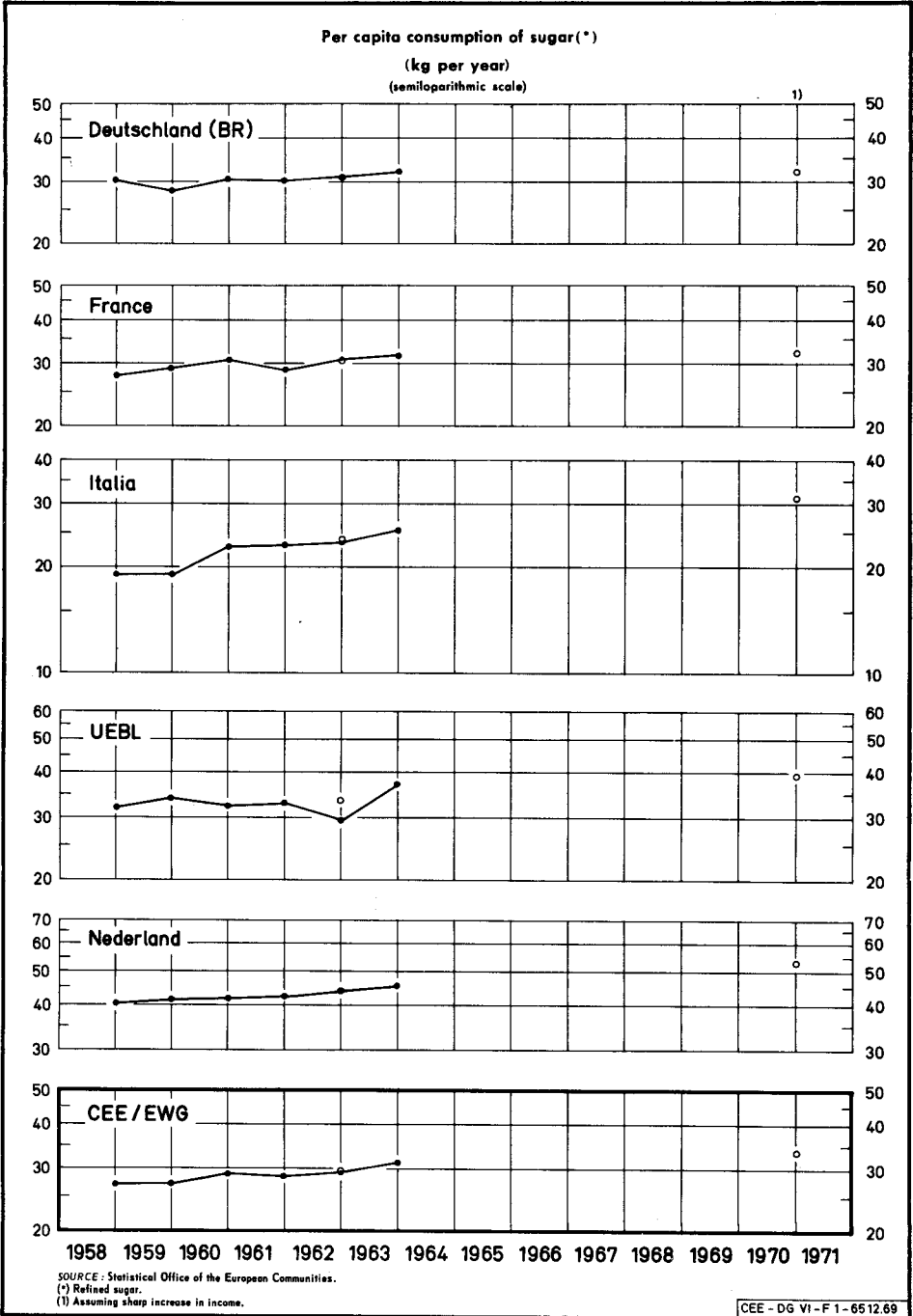

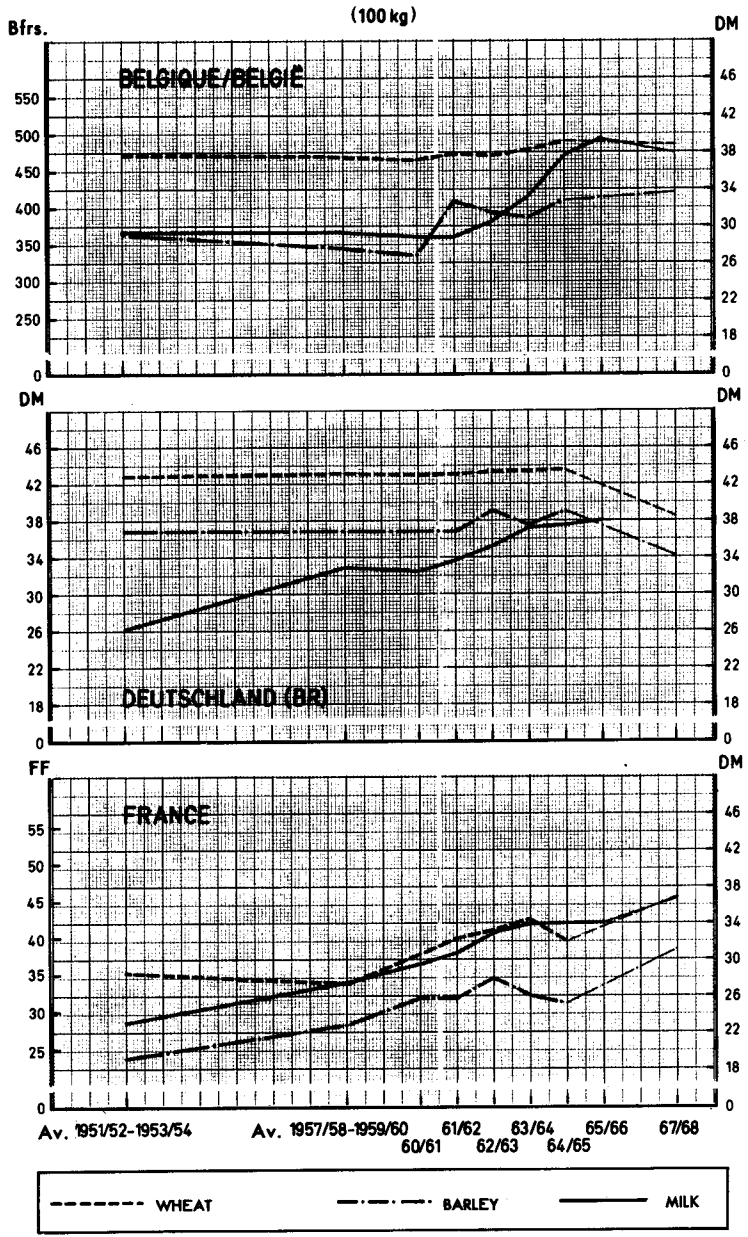

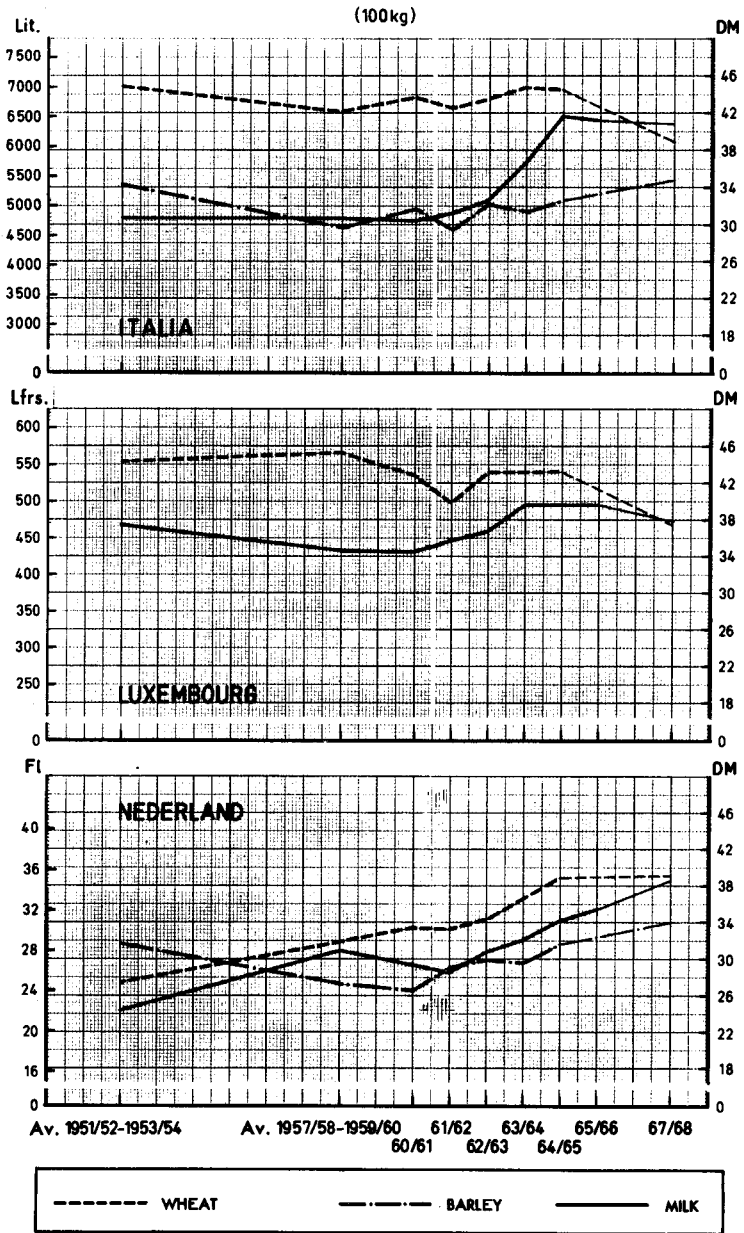

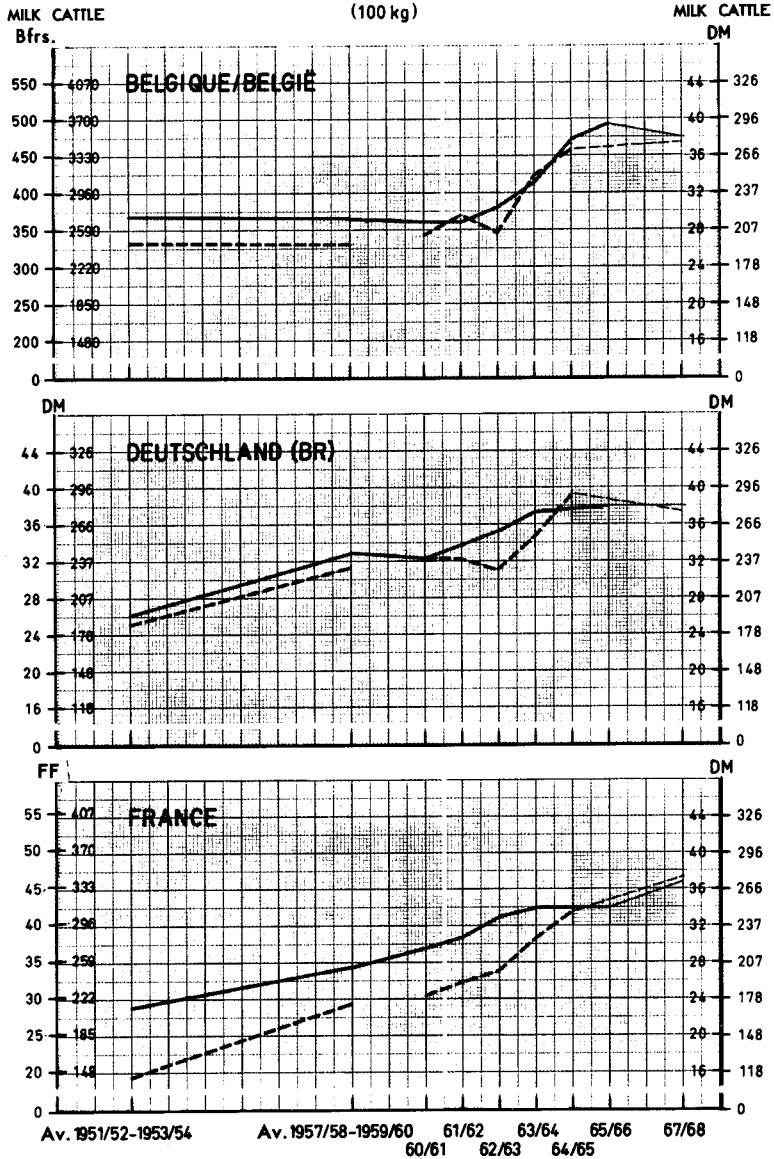
Producer prices for wheat other than durum, barley and milk

(first quality, live weight)

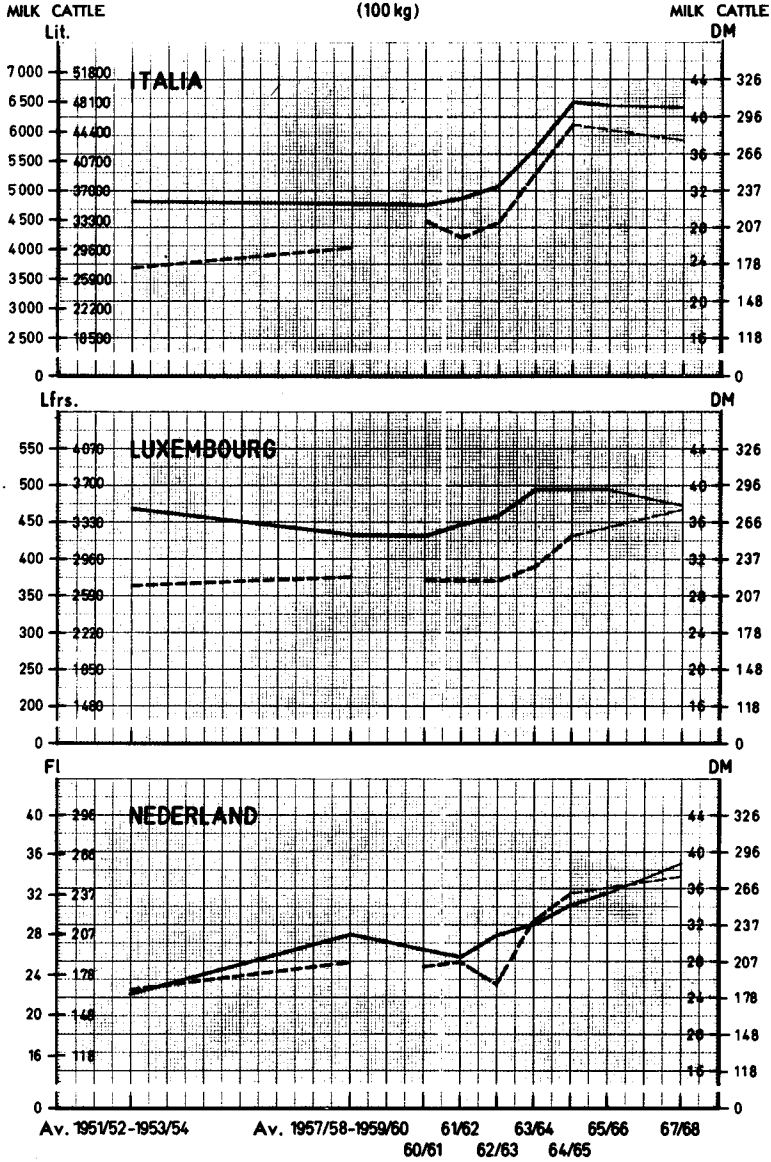

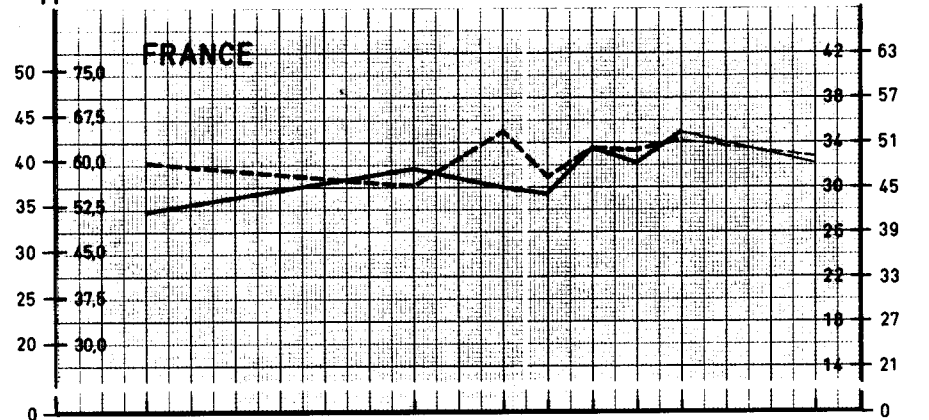

(100 kg)

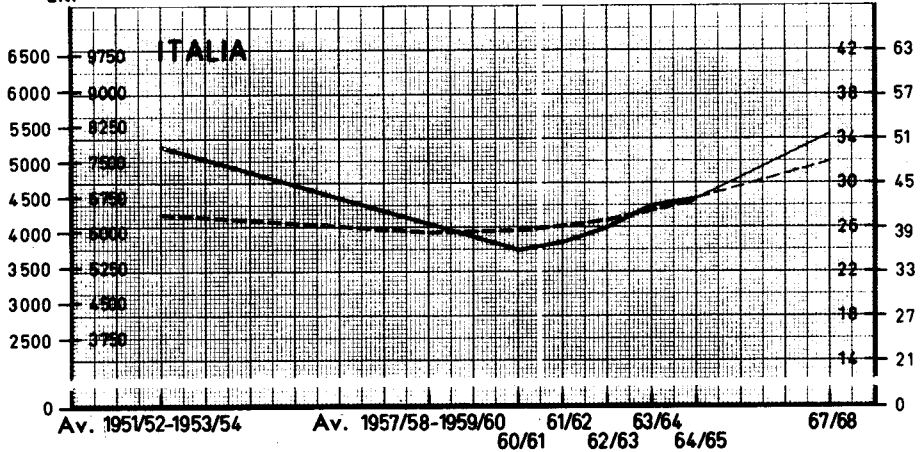

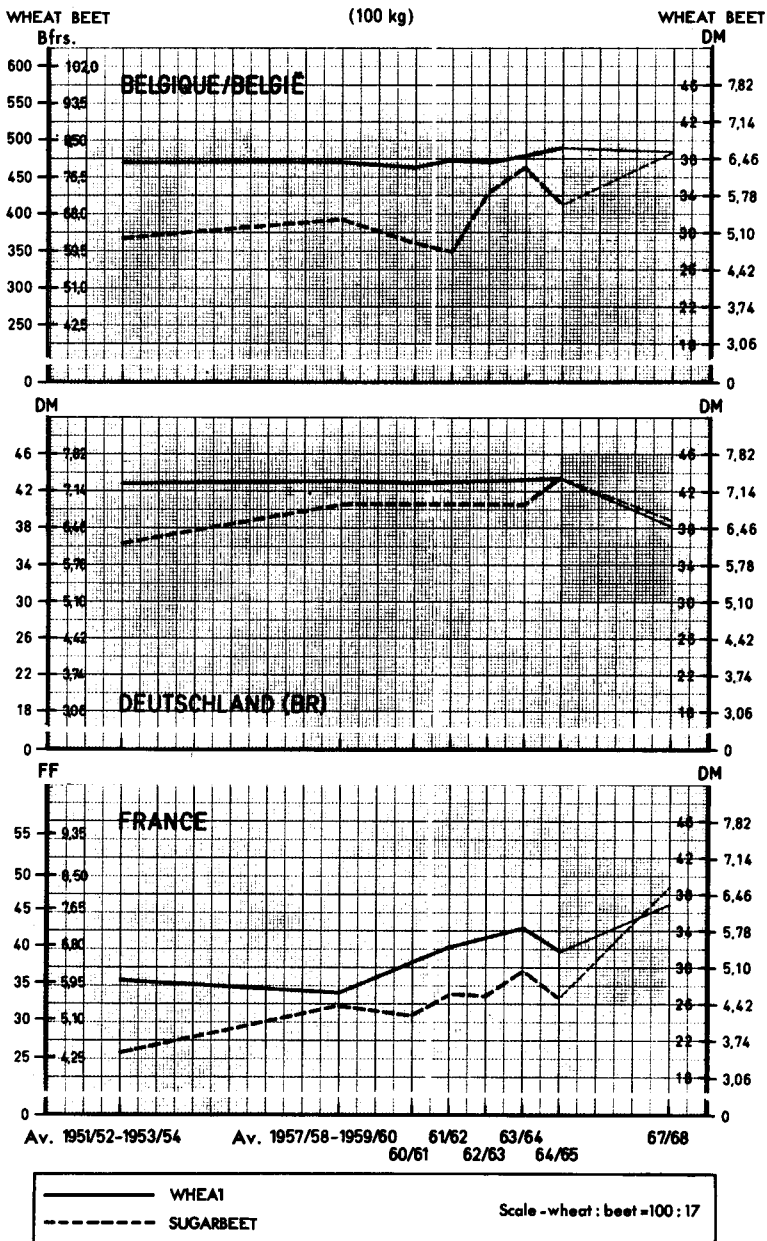

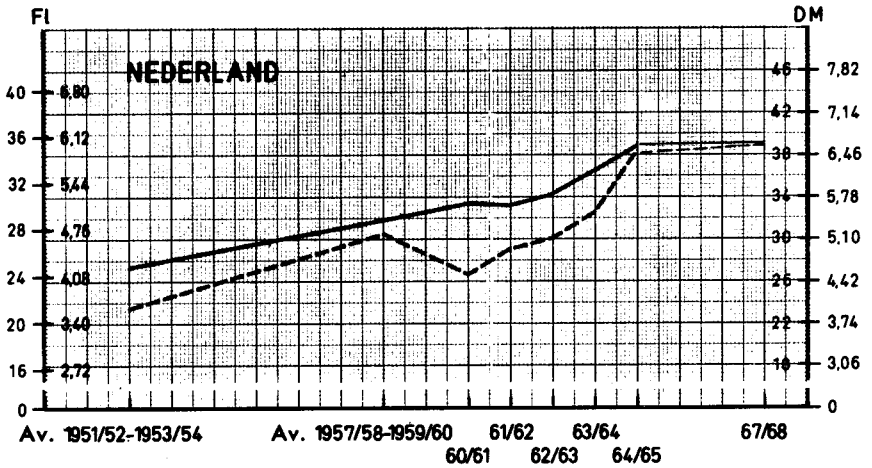
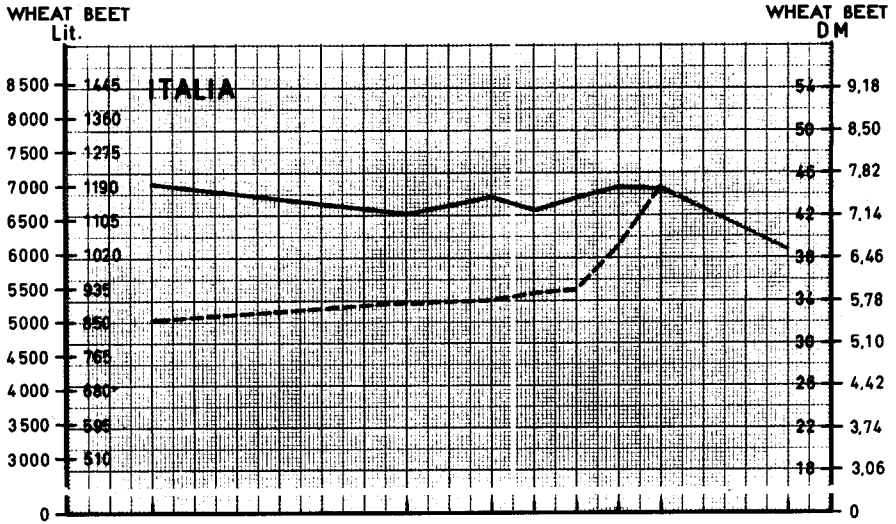
Producer prices for wheat other than durum and sugarbeet

(100kg)



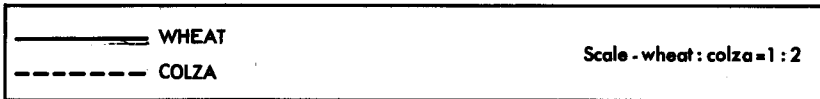
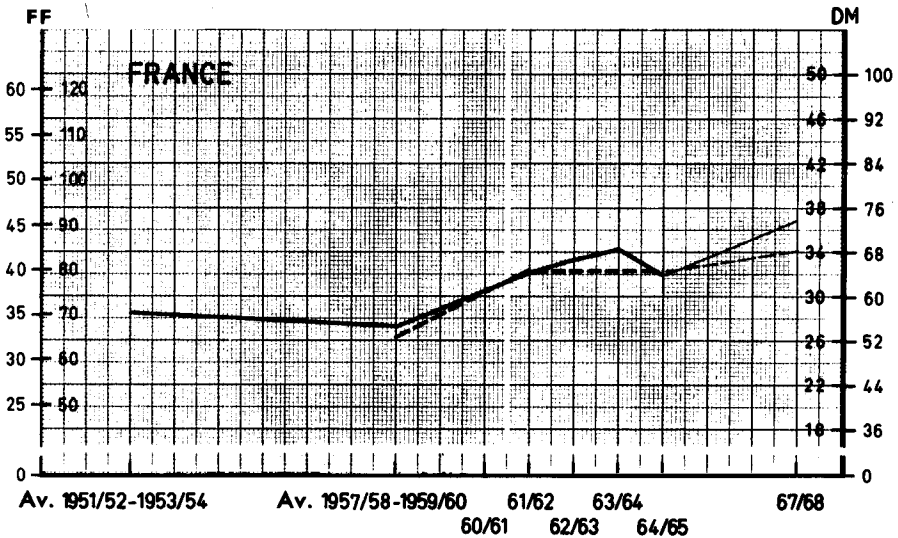
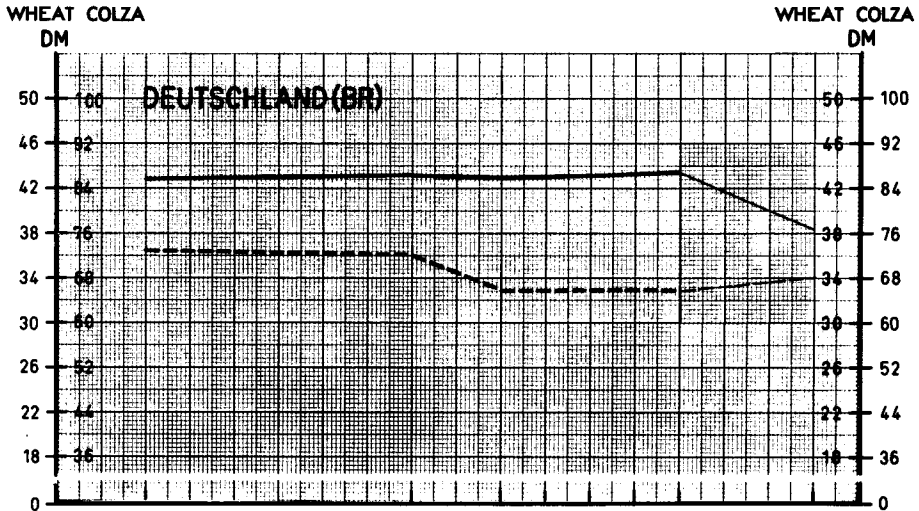
