**COMMISSION APPROVES FIRST GRANTS FROM REGIONAL FUND:  
160 MILLION U.A. FOR THE DEVELOPMENT REGIONS**

The Commission has announced its decision to grant financial aid to the member governments in respects of 655 investment projects representing a total investment of 1,234 m.u.a. in the Community's less-favoured regions. The total Regional Fund aid involved is 160 m.u.a., which is just over half of the 300 m.u.a. available during 1975. This is the first allocation of funds from the European Regional Development Fund. The remaining funds for this year will be allocated in December.

Infrastructure projects account for 100 m.u.a. (448 projects) including 10 m.u.a. (95 projects) for rural infrastructure in deprived agricultural areas. The remaining 60 m.u.a. are for 207 investment projects in the industrial, handicraft and service sectors, creating or maintaining over 36,000 jobs.

The attached lists give a national and regional breakdown of the aids granted. Clearly one must not try to assess the overall impact of the Regional Fund, which will have a continuing activity, on the basis of this first allocation of grants. Any initial imbalances between regions or different types of projects will be ironed out as future allocations are made.

It will be remembered that the European Regional Development Fund was established on 18th March 1975 (1), with a total of 1,300 m.u.a. at its disposal over the three years 1975-77. The Fund's resources are used to part-finance certain types of regional aid which the governments give thus releasing national resources which can then be used to finance other regional development projects. Thus the combination of national and Community funds can help a larger total number of projects, and create a larger number of new jobs. This will help reduce regional disparities which are greater at Community than at national level.

The fund can help finance industrial, handicraft and service investments in the regions which are eligible for national regional aids and which aim to create new jobs or help safeguard existing ones which might otherwise be threatened. It can also help finance infrastructure projects which are directly linked to the type of job-creating investments referred to above. Examples of such projects approved this time are in the fields of industrial estates, transport and communications and energy supply. Thirdly, the Fund can also aid certain types of infrastructure projects in agricultural areas facing special problems of geography, climate, etc. (mountain areas, for example).

As far as this first allocation is concerned, the applications were received from governments between early August and mid-September. They were processed by the Regional Policy Directorate General, in consultation with other services,

in time to be sent to the members of the Management Committee at the end of September.

The Committee met to give its opinion on October 14/15, after which the Commission was able to take its decision. The speed at which the applications have been dealt with was greatly helped by using a standard form of application and by the many bilateral contacts which took place between the Commission's services and the member governments in order to determine which of the projects proposed to us were suitable to receive aid from the Regional Fund.

La Commission approuve les premières subventions du Fonds régional  
160 millions d'U.C. pour les régions de développement

La Commission a annoncé sa décision d'accorder aux gouvernements des Etats membres une aide financière portant sur 655 projets d'investissements à réaliser dans les régions défavorisées de la Communauté, projets représentant un investissement total de 1.234 millions d'U.C. L'intervention du Fonds régional s'élève au total à 160 millions d'U.C. soit un peu plus de la moitié des 300 millions d'U.C. disponibles pour 1975. Il s'agit de la première répartition de crédits du Fonds européen de développement régional. Le solde des crédits au titre de la présente année sera distribué en décembre.

Les projets d'infrastructures représentent 100 millions d'U.C. (448 projets), dont 10 millions d'U.C. (95 projets) destinés aux infrastructures rurales dans les zones agricoles défavorisées. Les 60 millions d'U.C. restants concernent 207 projets d'investissement dans les secteurs de l'industrie, de l'artisanat et des services (création ou maintien de plus de 36.000 emplois).

Les listes ci-jointes donnent la ventilation, par pays et par région, des aides accordées. Il ne faut évidemment pas essayer de juger en fonction de cette première répartition de crédits l'impact global du Fonds régional, dont l'activité se poursuivra de façon continue. Tout déséquilibre initial entre régions ou entre différents types de projets sera compensé au fur et à mesure des futures répartitions.

Il convient de rappeler que le Fonds européen de développement régional a été institué le 18 mars 1975 (1) et qu'il dispose d'un montant total de 1.300 millions d'U.C. pour les trois années 1975 à 1977. Les crédits du Fonds servent à participer au financement de certains types d'aide régionale accordée par les gouvernements et permettent d'affecter les crédits nationaux ainsi libérés au financement d'autres projets de développement régional. La combinaison de crédits nationaux et communautaires permet donc de soutenir un nombre total de projets plus important et de créer un plus grand nombre d'emplois nouveaux. Ceci contribuera à réduire les disparités régionales, qui sont plus grandes au niveau communautaire qu'au niveau national.

Le Fonds peut contribuer à financer des investissements en faveur de l'industrie, de l'artisanat et des services dans les régions admises à bénéficier des aides nationales à finalité régionale qui désirent créer de nouveaux emplois ou préserver les emplois existants qui, autrement, risqueraient de disparaître. Il peut également contribuer à financer des projets d'infrastructures directement liés au type d'investissements créateurs d'emplois évoqués ci-dessus.
