COMMUNICATION FROM THE COMMISSION TO THE COUNCIL

First three-year Community plan of action in
the field of scientific and technical information:
amended proposal

In its opinion of 13th January 1975 (FE 38.725/def.) in which the European Parliament approved the proposal for a first three-year Community plan of action in the field of scientific and technical information (which the Commission had submitted to the Council on 18th September 1974), the Parliament requested that the Commission submit to it an annual report on the progress of the work, and suggested that Article 2 of the proposal for a Council Decision be amended accordingly.

The Commission has carefully considered this request and has decided, in accordance with Article 149, second paragraph EEC Treaty, to take account in its proposal of the amendment suggested by the Parliament.

Article 2

The Commission shall be responsible for the execution of this plan of action, assisted by the Committee for Information and Documentation in Science and Technology (CIDST). This Committee and the Scientific and Technical Research Committee (CREST) shall be kept regularly informed of the progress of the work. Furthermore, the Commission shall submit a full report to the Council each year.

New version proposed to take account of the opinion of the Parliament

Article 2

The Commission shall be responsible for the execution of this plan of action, assisted by the Committee for Information and Documentation in Science and Technology (CIDST). This Committee and the Scientific and Technical Research Committee (CREST) shall be kept regularly informed of the progress of the work. Furthermore, the Commission shall submit each year to the Council and the Parliament a full report that will figure in the general report.

The other parts of the Proposal remain unchanged.
