RECOMMENDATION FOR A DECISION OF THE COUNCIL amending and supplementing the directives for negotiations with Malta

commission Communication to the Council on improvements to the directive for negotiations with Malta in the fields of rules of origin and co-operation

- 1. At the first round of talks between the Community and Malta on 25 September 1974 with a view to extending the present EEC-Malta Association Agreement to the fields of co-operation and agriculture and adapting the Agreement because of the enlargement of the Community, the Maltese Delegation requested improvements to the Community offer, which it found unacceptable in its present form.
- 2. Firstly the Maltese Delegation considers that the agricultural concessions need to be improved both as to the level of tariff reductions and as to the extension of the periods of application for the products covered by the Community offer. Secondly, it considers that new products of relevance to Malta's agriculture should be included in this offer.

Malta's position is based in particular on the need to develop and diversify its agricultural exports, to make the tariff concessions coincide with the seasonal pattern of Malta's agricultual production and to avoid discrimination in the treatment which the Community will apply to agricultural products from the Mediterranean countries.

In the light of the decisions taken for the other Mediterranean countries and in view of Malta's quite special situation, the Commission considers that the Community can go at least some way towards Malta's requests and to this end proposes the inclusion of the solutions set out in the Annexe to the negotiating directives.

3. The Maltese Delegation considers, moreover, that the proposed provisions concerning the rules of origin do not meet the development requirements of the island's industry in certain specific sectors.

In this connection and, more particularly, in the context of Lists A and B and with a view to the possible adaptation of the rules of origin by reference to technical developments, the Commission proposes to the Council that the directives for negotiations be supplemented by a provision under which the Council Association would be empowered to modify the rules of origin, as was decided in respect of the Maghreb countries.

The main problem, however, continues to be financial co-operation. The Government of Malta regard the Community's offer in this field as altogether inadequate and, furthermore, ill-suited to the special situation of the island and its economy. It requests that the Community aid amount to not less than 30 million u.a.

In this connection the Commission recalls the suggestion which it made to the Council in March 1974 for aid totalling 30 million u.a. and the offer made by the Community of 21 million u.a.

An amount somewhere between these figures will therefore have to be fixed at a level which, in view of Malta's special situation, is such that the negotiations can be concluded.

Recommendation for a Decision of the Council amending and supplementing the directives for negotiations with Malta

The Council of the European Communities,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community, and in particular Article 238 thereof;

Having regard to the Recommendation from the Commission;

Whereas the Council, by its Decision of 25 September 1972, authorized the Commission to open negotiations with a view to the conclusion of a supplementary protocol to the Association Agreement between EED and Malta and whereas it adopted supplementary negotiating directives by the Decision of 22 and 23 July 1974;

Whereas those directives should be amended and supplemented so that négotiations may be resumed;

HAS DECIDED AS FOLLOWS:

Sole Article

The supplementary directives adopted by Decision of the Council on 22 and 23 July 1974 shall be amended and supplemented by the directives annexed to this Decision.

ANNEX

I. TRADE IN AGRICULTURAL PRODUCTS

Arrangements for Community imports

- 1. The Community should reduce duties on the agricultural products from Malta listed in annexed table, as indicated therein.
- 2. The other provisions laid down in the directives of 22 and 23 July 1974 remain unaltered.

II. RULES OF ORIGIN

The Council of Association would be empowered to decide on any modification of the rules of origin.
