**I. Total production**

The figures for the 1995/96 wine year were the first to include Austrian wine production. However, the harvest was down very slightly on the previous year, being the smallest since the introduction of the common organisation of the market in wine at 9% lower than the average for the previous five wine years. Nevertheless, the production of quality wines psr was up, on both the previous year (up 5%) and the average over the previous five years (up 6%). The production of table wine, however, fell 1.8% on the previous year and 16.4% on the average for the previous five years.

**II. Utilisation**

The balance from the 1995/96 wine year is for EUR-15, since the market organisation rules were applied immediately in the new Member States, Austria, Finland and Sweden. Total utilisation in EUR-15 in the 1995/96 wine year, comprising human consumption, industrial uses (including juices), losses, Community distillation and net exports to third countries, was 151 823 hl.

1. Human consumption

Direct human consumption in EUR-15 in 1995/96 totalled 129 million hl, 2.5% down on both the previous year and the average over the 1990/91 to 1994/95 wine years. It is interesting to see that consumption continues to grow in the non-producer countries (+11% in Belgium, +7% in the United Kingdom, +22% in Ireland and +8% in the Netherlands) while falling in the producer countries (-2.6% in Greece, -9.5% in Spain, -4.3% in France, -3.3% in Italy and -2.3% in Portugal).

The fall in total consumption is due to the fact that the continuing positive trend in the consumption of quality wines psr (+1%) was not enough to offset the fall in the consumption of table wine (-1.9%). This becomes even clearer when one looks at the average for the last five wine years: an increase of 4.2% in the consumption of quality wines psr and a fall of 7.7% in that of table wines.

## 2. Industrial uses

These include the quantities used for the production of brandy with a registered designation of origin (5.65 million hl of wine), juices (3.26 million hl), vermouths (2.18 million hl) and vinegar (1.22 million hl). Overall, these uses absorbed 12.31 million hl.

## 3. Community distillation

Since the harvest was small, obligatory distillation was not introduced for the second successive wine year. The total volume distilled (apart from 4.5 million hl of by-products of wine-making) was 2 million hl. This was a reduction of 4 million hl on the previous year, in which the harvest was also small, and of 19 million and 27 million hl on the 1993/94 and 1992/93 wines years respectively.

## 4. Imports and exports

Intra-Community trade involved around 30 million hl. Exports from EUR-15 to third countries during the 1995/96 wine year totalled 9.7 million hl, down 13% on the previous year. Of this, 2.15 million hl were exported with a refund.

The Community imported 7 million hl from third countries, 83% more than in 1994/95. The reduction in exports and the large increase in imports are explained by the low level of Community production.

## III. Stocks

Stocks of table wine in the EUR-15 at the end of the wine year were up 4.5 million hl, or 11%, but stocks of quality wine psr were down slightly (-0.2 million hl). It is clear that, although production during the year would have been insufficient to cover all requirements, i.e. including the production of wine spirits, it was more than enough to cover other needs. This, and the worsening of the balance between imports and exports, led to an increase in stocks of table wine.

#### **IV. Conclusions**

For the second successive year, the harvest was small and insufficient to cover needs if one includes the volume of wine required to supply the market for potable alcohol. There has been a shift in demand to quality wines, with the ratio of human consumption of table wine to quality wine psr falling from 2.1:1 in 1986/87, to 1.5:1 five years ago and to 1.3:1 in 1995/96.
