PREFACE

According to tradition, the Consultative Committee holds one Session in the country of the President. On this occasion (the 158th Session) the members of the Consultative Committee were the guests of the coal and steel industry of the United Kingdom and the British government.

On 30 August 1973, the death occurred of Mr. Roland LABBE, who had been a member of the Consultative Committee since 1957 in the producers' category. On 3 February 1974 the death occurred of Mr. Domenico TACCONE, a member of the Consultative Committee since 1953 in the consumers' and dealers' category. Mr. TACCONE had been the Senior President of the Committee since 1964.

During the 160th Session, the Consultative Committee adopted new Internal Regulations, necessitated by the entry of Denmark, Ireland and the United Kingdom. This is now the fifth revised version.

At the invitation of the Bureau, the President and a delegation from the Economic and Social Committee (EEC/EAEC) took part in its 229th meeting. A report on energy problems was jointly prepared. Finally the delegation took part in a debate on energy problems at the 161st Session.


