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TO THE MEMBER STATES CONCERNING THE REQUIREMENT FOR STEEL DEALERS
TO DECLARE THE QUANTITIES OF CERTAIN STEEL PRODUCTS RECEIVED AND
DELIVERED

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Coal and Steel Community,

and in particular Article 95 thereof, alinea 1;

Having obtained the unanimous assent of the Council and consulted the Consultative Committee

Whereas the steel market continues to be seriously affected by the deterioration of the economic situation, whereas the level of demand varies from one Member State to another and is helping to create major price differences between the various Community markets;

Whereas this situation creates changes harmful to the pattern of deliveries;

Whereas this changes are a major factor in the imbalance in the market for steel products;

Whereas it is essential to m_{ϕ} intain the unity of the Community steel market and tighten up discipline with regard to quantities and prices ;

Whereas the steel market constitutes a whole in which dealers help to market a large proportion of steel products, including those imported from third countries;

Whereas the statistics on the quantities of steel products received and delivered by steel dealers do not at present enable the Commission to have an exact and complete picture of the movements of steel products resulting from the activities of the said dealers;

Whereas such statistics represent an aid to detecting infringements of the pricing rules; whereas the information will also help to improve market forecasts and the fixing of abatement rates, and whereas the Commission therefore has to have very precise information on deliveries from both steel dealers and steel undertakings;

Whereas it is necessary that the Member States take all appropriate measures to require steel dealers to declare the quantities of certain steel products received and delivered; whereas the Member States must ensure compliance with this obligation and check the declarations;

Whereas the Member States should also record the amounts of the products in question that are imported, so that they can be classified statistically by sector and by undertaking of origin;

Whereas the measures to be taken by the Member States must be appropriate to the objective pursued and must comply with the provisions of the Treaty on the free movement of goods;

Whereas the Member States should process the declarations and information forwarded to them; whereas they should regularly inform the Commission of the results of inspections carried out and make available to the Commission at its request any information it may consider necessary;

HAS ADOPTED THIS RECOMMENDATION

ARTICLE 1

With effect from 1 January 1983 Member States shall implement measures to ensure that the dealers in steel products referred to in Article 2 are subject to the obligations set out in this Recommendation and to impose controls and penalties to ensure compliance with the said obligations.

ARTICLE 2

For the purposes of this Recommendation the following shall be regarded as "dealers in steel products":

 distributive undertakings selling ex-stock the steel products defined in Annex 1 to this Recommendation and those marketing such steel products after having processed them;

for the purposes of this Recommencation processing shall be deemed to have taken place when the products referred to in Annex 1 of the said Recommendation are converted:

- either into another steel product listed in the said Annexes, by means of an operation other than rolling;
- or into a product obtained from slitting cold-rolled plate into coil 500 mm wide or over;
- 2. distributive undertakings selling direct the steel products defined in Annex I originating in third countries.

Article 3

Dealers in steel products shall be required to declare to the authority designated by the Member State the quantities of Annex I products received and delivered by them. That authority shall have the power to check these declarations on the dealers' premises.

Article 4

For each of the steel products listed in Annex I to this Recommendation the Member States shall record the amounts imported, so as to permit their statistical classification by sector and by undertaking of origin (producers, dealers selling steel products ex-stock and undertakings distributing steel products originating in third countries).

Article 5

Member States shall:

- ensure that the declarations and information referred to in Articles 3 and
 4 are processed and put to use;
- 2. send the Commission, within six weeks of the last day of each month, a summary of the data for the month elapsed, broken down by product, Member State and sector of activity.

The Commission shall lay down the procedures for the application of this provision.

Article 6

Dealers in steel products which fail to fulfill their obligations under these provisions as regards the implementation of Article 3, or which provide false or incomplete information, shall be liable to appropriate fines not exceeding 1 % of their annual turnover and penalty payments of up to a maximum of 5 % of their average daily turnover per day of delay.

Article 7

This Recommendation is addressed to the Member States.
