The Financial Regulations applicable to the European Development Funds require the Commission to draw up accounts each year, for all active Funds, showing all revenue and expenditure between 1 January and 31 December and balance sheets showing the situation at 31 December, accompanied by statements showing movements of the accounts during the year.

Having approved these accounts, the Commission must send them to the Court of Auditors, Parliament and the Council.

**GENERAL DESCRIPTION OF COMMUNITY AID
TO THE ACP STATES
UNDER THE EUROPEAN DEVELOPMENT FUNDS**

I.1. INTRODUCTION

The European Community and its Member States together constitute the world's leading source of official development assistance : Community aid proper and the contributions of the individual Member States jointly account for more than a third of the total development aid received by the developing countries. Nearly two thirds of the aid received by Africa is provided from this joint source, which also accounts for approximately one third of aid to Oceania, Asia and the Middle East.

Community aid and aid from the Member States combined represent 43 % of world aid, making the Twelve the principal donor, far outstripping the United States and Japan.

I.2. THE HISTORICAL BACKGROUND

The Community's development cooperation policy came into being at the same time as the Community itself. The first European Development Fund (EDF) was established in 1958, when the process of decolonization was not yet over. At the time it covered only 18 African countries and Madagascar which, following their independence, signed the first and then the second **Yaoundé Conventions**.

After these agreements came the four **Lomé Conventions**, named after the Togolese capital where they were signed in 1975, 1979, 1984 and 1989. These Conventions represent the most far-reaching and lasting North-South cooperation agreement ever signed, under which the 12 Member States of the Community have as their partners 70 **African, Caribbean and Pacific** countries.

Alongside the Lomé Conventions, the Council of Ministers has brought out its successive Decisions on the Association of the overseas countries and territories (OCT) to the Community which provide the basis for cooperation between the Community and the OCT. So EEC-ACP and EEC-OCT cooperation is still the cornerstone of the Community's development policy in terms of both finance and trade. Thirty-five years later, the Community and its cooperation policy have grown in stature and scope. In 1994 there are few developing countries which have not established special ties with the Community and even fewer which do not receive some form of Community aid.

I.3. RESOURCES : PROGRAMMABLE & NON-PROGRAMMABLE AID

EDF resources are divided into **programmable aid** and **non-programmable aid**. The EU and its partners negotiate the use of programmable aid and produce an indicative programme for the ACP or overseas country or territory in question. This is an outline document covering five years of financial and technical cooperation between the two partners and focussing on main needs such as training, food self-sufficiency, infrastructures, industrial investment, etc. Programmable aid also includes an allocation for each region, for the financing of regional cooperation projects and programmes.

Non-programmable aid (which includes, for example, Stabex, Sysmin, risk capital and emergency humanitarian relief), for which objective criteria of allocation are laid down in advance, is not earmarked for any particular state.

EDF resources, other than risk capital and interest-rate subsidies which are handled by the European Investment Bank, are managed by the Commission. They are renewed whenever a new Convention or a new OCT association decision is signed.

With the signing of Lomé IV on 15 December 1989, its entry into force on 1st September 1991 and the accession of Eritrea in 1993, **70 ACP States** and **20 OCTs** now benefit from the European Development Fund (EDF) - whose First Financial Protocol makes available some 10940 MECU (of which 140 MECU for the OCT). To this can be added the European Investment Bank participation of 1225 MECU (of which 25 MECU for OCT). The Internal Agreement governing the financing and management of Lomé IV stipulates how the resources are to be allocated.

I.4. THE EDF AND OTHER COMMUNITY INSTRUMENTS

The EDF is different from the other financial instruments covered by the General Budget :

- its resources are supplied, outside the Budget, by the EC Member States according to a formula fixed for each EDF ;
- a Financial Regulation is established for each EDF which defines how the Internal Agreement is to be applied particularly in relation to accounting and legal aspects.

As a result, the traditional regulations relating to budgetary credits are not applicable to the EDF. The latter, in fact, operates on the basis of credits which are :

- allocated to certain operations specifically identified ;
- multi-annual, that is available for a minimum of five years and subject to a ceiling fixed precisely at the outset of each Convention.

The Commission thus has the task of managing, simultaneously, several EDFs until their definitive closure.

I.5. EXPLANATION OF THE MAIN TERMS AND ABBREVIATIONS USED IN THE REPORT

ACP

African, Caribbean and Pacific.

ACP States

States signatory to the Lomé Convention(s).

Authorization

Authorization of payments by Authorizing Officer as required by the Financial Regulation governing the application of each Financial Protocol.

Counterpart funds

Local currency equivalent of aid either in the form of products sold (food aid) or of foreign exchange to finance sectoral or general import programmes.

Debt programme

Special Community programme for certain highly indebted African countries (Council Decision of 14 December 1987).

Decisions

Initial commitment of funds (also called primary commitments or projects). Also includes as negative values the de-commitments of funds remaining when a project is closed.

Delegated appropriations

Second level of commitments (also called secondary commitments, contracts or assigned funds). An assignment of funds generally representing contractual commitments taken by the ACP States ; also includes as negative values the release of funds when a contract is completed and no further payments are to be made.

EDF

European Development Fund :

- Sixth EDF : third Lomé Convention signed on 8 December 1984 (Lomé III).
- Seventh EDF : fourth Lomé Convention signed on 15 December 1989 (Lomé IV).

Emergency aid

Emergency assistance is granted to ACP States faced with serious economic and social difficulties of an exceptional nature resulting from natural disasters or extraordinary circumstances having comparable effects. The assistance is intended to make, by the most suitable means, a real contribution to remedying the immediate difficulties. It is now managed by ECHO (European Community Humanitarian Office).

GIP

General Import Programme.

Interest-rate subsidies

Loans from the European investment Bank's own resources are subject to a rate of interest. This rate is reduced by means of a subsidy. The amount of the interest-rate subsidy calculated in terms of its value at the time of disbursement of the loan is charged against the amount of grants and paid directly to the Bank.

Mining products

See Sysmin.

NIP

National Indicative Programme - Programmable Aid (see below).

Non-programmable Aid

All amounts falling outside Programmable Aid e.g. Stabex, Sysmin, Emergency/Refugees Aid.

OCT

Overseas Countries and Territories.

Payments

Sums paid during the calendar year including down-payments and advances (also includes, as negative values, sums re-paid).

Programmable Aid

The overall amounts placed at the disposal of each ACP State or region, for the period covered by the Financial Protocol, on the basis of the indicative programmes agreed between the Community and the ACP State concerned.

Recovery and rehabilitation plan

Rehabilitation and recovery plan for African countries most affected by drought : a package of measures originally designed to help the economic recovery of sub-Saharan countries hard hit by the 1984-85 drought and prevent fresh disaster (Council Decision of 4 November 1985). A fresh initiative was launched under the Danish Presidency in 1993 to the extent of ECU 100 million.

Refugees aid

Assistance is available to ACP States taking in refugees or returnees to meet acute needs not covered by emergency assistance, to implement in the longer term projects and action programme aimed at self-sufficiency and the integration or reintegration of such people. Similar assistance may be envisaged to help with the voluntary integration or reintegration of persons who have had to leave their homes as a result of conflicts or natural disasters.

Risk capital

Risk capital from the fund may be provided in the form of loans or equity participation. In the case of loans, it may be provided mainly in the form of subordinated loans (redeemed only after other claims have been settled), or conditional loans (linked to the fulfilment of certain conditions with regard to the performance of the project financed). For equity participation, it may be provided to acquire temporary minority holdings on behalf of the Community in the capital of ACP enterprises or institutions financing development projects in the ACP States or of ACP financial institutions promoting and financing private investment in the ACP States. Such EDF expenditure is repayable to the Member States : the EIB is responsible for collection of these monies and credits all such amounts received to special accounts of the Member States in proportion to their contributions to the Fund from which the sums are derived unless the Council decides to allocate them to other operations.

SIP

Sectoral Import Programme.

Stabex

System for stabilizing the export earnings of ACP States from products on which their economies depend which are affected by fluctuations in price or quantity.

Structural Adjustment

A package of measures designed to restructure developing countries' domestic and external finances, in coordination with traditional long-term development schemes and with other funds (IMF, World Bank, etc.). Generally financed with resources from both the structural adjustment facility (SAF) and, where appropriate, the National Indicative Programme.

Structural Adjustment Facility (SAF)

A new system of support for economic rationalisation (structural adjustment) policies. Many of the ACPs have experienced unprecedented economic and financial crises since the early '80s, typically with a series of imbalances in their structures - in the balance of payments, the budget, their public firms, inflation, debt and so on. The viability and efficiency of projects in these countries cannot be ensured without general or sectoral reforms : structural adjustment is the result of this need to strike all the balances again.

Sysmin

Special financing facility for ACP States where the mining industry is of economic importance and undergoing difficulties (or likely to) in the near future.

Transfers to or from other Funds

Balances remaining from the European Development Fund which have not been committed or disbursed by the end of the last year of the appropriate Financial Protocol. Transfers can also be made on decisions e.g. insufficiency of Stabex resources.

1994 PROGRAMMED AID

II.1. IMPLEMENTATION OF NATIONAL INDICATIVE PROGRAMMES (NIPs)

II.1.1. Lomé III

Nine years after the start of Lomé III, the NIPs have achieved a satisfactory state of implementation.

Total decisions taken now amount to 3.97 billions Ecu, or 96% of the overall allocation. Delegated appropriations and payments amount to, respectively, 3.42 BECU (83% of the allocation) and 3.04 BECU (74%).

Programmable aid decisions, unlike fast-disbursing instruments, are translated into payments only after two years or more.

Countries where delay has developed at the level of decisions are Ghana, Sudan, Zaire, Antigua/Barbuda, Barbados, Suriname and Fiji. It should be noted, however, that for certain countries the allocation is not very large : the rate of decisions, in percentage terms, should therefore be appraised in the light of such amounts, to which should be added those available under other EDFs.

II.1.2. Lomé IV

In 1994, the Commission effectively completed the programming of Community aid under Lomé IV's first Financial Protocol. Three new national indicative programmes were signed, with Suriname in April 1994, with Eritrea in May and with Haiti in December, bringing to 66 the total number of NIPs concluded under the 7th EDF. The political or security situation in four ACP countries - one of which, Somalia, has still not been able to ratify the 4th Convention - meant that discussions with these states could not be undertaken.

For the Rwanda crisis, 150 MECU in additional resources were made available at the end of July, from unused resources under previous EDFs, to remedy the exhaustion of emergency aid funds and to respond to the immediate needs of the victims of the conflict.

In addition to the existing rehabilitation programmes in the Horn of Africa and Southern Africa, new actions were approved for Liberia, Zaire and Madagascar. Combining EDF resources and Budget funds, the rehabilitation measures under way at the end of 1994, in ACP countries alone, represented some 520 MECU in Community aid.

Decisions under NIPs for Lomé IV in 1994 were 702 MECU, making a total to date of 2.6 Billion Ecu (55% of the allocation). Delegated appropriations and payments in 1994 amounted to 480 MECU and 311 MECU respectively, representing a total of 1.1 Billion Ecu (23% of the allocation) for appropriations and 574 MECU (12% of the allocation) for payments.

The average decision rate for the NIPs thus reached 59% at end 1994, rising to 62% if countries which have not signed their NIP are excluded from the calculations. In score of countries the rate of decision has already exceeded 80% : ten have already committed practically the whole of their allocations.

II.1.3. Evaluation of aid from the European Union

The year 1994 saw a consolidation of the introduction of the project cycle management method, following publication of the Manual "Project cycle management - integrated approach and logical framework" and a series of training seminars for Commission personnel and ACP administrations.

The method aims at deepening dialogue with the ACP States as well as improving the identification , implementation, monitoring and the evaluation of development projects and programmes, with the emphasis on long term aid efficiency.

At the of 1994, 8000 copies of this Manual in English, French and Spanish were distributed to Community officials and to ACP Countries : 650 persons attended training courses on the method's application.

The first fruits of the approach can now be seen in improved project quality, particularly in respect of their preparatory phases (identification and planning).

1994 also saw the completion of several evaluations on sectors or themes : those initiated during the year concerned institutional development, human rights and democracy, "culture and development", "trade", lines of credit and support for SMEs, tourism and the evaluation of 3 programmes of structural adjustment.

FINANCIAL PROGRESS OF ACP AID

At the close of the accounting year 1994, the total volume of decisions generated during that period (2.4 BECU) for 6th and 7th EDF operations (the two Funds currently managed by the Commission) is at a very high level.

The volume has markedly increased due to a renewal of STABEX operations suspended in 1993: decisions excluding STABEX show a decrease of 129 MECU (-6%) in comparison to the previous year (1.9 BECU in 1993, 1.8 BECU in 1994). In contrast, payments excluding STABEX show an increase of 15% : 1.2 BECU in 1993 compared to 1.4 BECU in 1994.

Overall, decisions, delegated appropriations and payments totalled respectively 2.4 BECU, 1.9 BECU and 1.8 BECU in 1994.

Annex XII-1 shows the evolution of the two EDF at the end of 1994.

III.1. LOME III

The Lomé III Convention, after nine years of implementation, is now nearing the end of its natural "life".

If its annual decisions have increased in comparison with the previous years (48 MECU in 1994 against 15 MECU in 1993) their level remains relatively low. From a base date of 1986, a total of 7.9 BECU, or 95% of the 6th EDF allocation, has now been attained.

Delegated appropriations declined yet further in 1994 - 181 MECU compared to 300 MECU in 1993, as did payments with a reduction of 20% reflecting a decline from 562 MECU to 440 MECU. Delegated appropriations and payments, in cumulative terms, now represent some 86% and 78% respectively of the allocation.

Annex XII-3 details the 6th EDF situation.

The 6th EDF ACP allocation was reduced from 7.933 BECU in 1993 to 7.781 BECU in 1994 : 153 MECU were transferred from 6th to 7th Fund, of which 127 MECU to Article 254 of Lomé IV so as to aid refugees and displaced persons in Rwanda, Burundi and neighbouring countries following the Council's decision of 27 July 1994; the remaining 26 MECU were transferred to 7th EDF from unused interest resources under 6th EDF.

III.2. LOME IV

After more than three years, the rate of implementation of Lomé IV continues to maintained : at end 1994, over 61% of the 7th Fund had been decided.

The rate of payments however does not match this rhythm, since an interval of 12-15 months elapses between a decision and its conversion into payment. In addition, multiannual indicative programmes need a longer gestation period, requiring the financing of studies and preparatory works at their initial stages.

Annex XII-4 details the 7th EDF situation.

Of the 7.1 BECU in decisions achieved at end 1994, 3.2 BECU represents programmable aid, 2.7 BECU non-programmable, 908 MECU Structural Adjustment and 318 MECU transfers from 5th EDF.

At the end of 1994, the 7th EDF allocation was increased by 214 MECU (+2%) compared to 1993 : 127 MECU from 6th EDF to bolster Article 254 refugee actions in Rwanda and neighbouring countries, 84 MECU from interest on STABEX funds deposited and 3 Mecu from Structural Adjustment funds on deposit.

The STABEX decisions of 615 MECU and of 350 MECU in payments reflect an exceptional year : it should be noted however that two application years were implemented in 1994 following a non-decision by the Committee of Ambassadors in 1992.

For programmable aid, the year 1994 has been characterised by a stabilisation in rate of decisions, an expansion of delegated appropriations and a real acceleration in level of payments.

LOME IV MID TERM REVIEW

Following the procedures set out in Article 366 of the Lomé IV Convention, on 28 February 1994 the ACP States and the Community exchanged views on their respective proposals for the Convention's mid-term review. As this was only a partial revision and not a full scale renegotiation the proposals concerned only a limited number of areas.

The negotiations formally opened on 19 May 1994 at the ACP-EC Council of Ministers meeting in MBABANE Swaziland. Three working groups supported by experts were established and held several plenary sessions during the year.

General consensus was reached on political and institutional questions, and on democracy and human rights. Measures to strengthen the process of political dialogue, and the parliamentary representation aspects of the Joint Assembly, were also examined. Human rights, democratic principles and the rule of law were recognised as essential elements in the Convention which should be positively encouraged as well as meriting protection, if need be, by a total or partial suspension of cooperation, subject to certain safeguards.

Trade should henceforth form the focal point of ACP-EC cooperation, supported by all the Convention's instruments, so as to improve the trade performance and competitive position of the ACP States.

On Stabex, a series of amendments was agreed.

General agreement was also reached on a number of other areas relating to the financial aspects of the development effort - greater flexibility in programming; an increased reflection of the Community's development objectives and priorities in the dialogue with each ACP State ; a consensus on the ACP States' proposals relating to structural adjustment.

Certain differences of view remained, concerning notably greater access for ACP agricultural products to the Community market and a reappraisal of the rules of origin.

MICROPROJECTS

- Articles 252, 253 of Lomé IV -

During 1994, 14 multiannual Micro-project programmes were adopted by signature of the Chief Authorizing Officer for a total of 38.2 MECUS.

To provide the financial basis for these actions, a fourth global authorization of 30 MECU was approved by the Commission on 12 April 1994, following the opinion of the EDF Committee.

Since the cumulative total decided since 1992 (111.4 MECU) amounts to some 126% of the total of such actions financed under Lomé III, it is evident that the micro-projects financial instrument is generating increasing interest.

The main sectors for micro-projects in 1994 were social and economic infrastructures in rural areas, in particular water supply, education and health.

Other actions were in the productive sector, notably agriculture and small business.

A general study on micro-projects was prepared and begun in 1994 to evaluate the role of this instrument.

NON-PROGRAMMABLE AID

VI.1. STABEX

The application year 1992 had been marked, like the two preceding years, by an insufficiency of the system's resources, but it had not been possible to achieve a consensus on the addition of supplementary credits to those already available (330 MECU).

Despite negotiations continuing until January 1994, no agreement was forthcoming. In the absence of such a consensus, the ACP-EC Committee of Ambassadors decided, on 16.02.1994, that the transfers would be effected on the basis of available resources (330 MECU), the eligible amounts so covered amounting to 43,2%.

For the application year 1993, it was established that 36 ACP States could benefit from 57 transfers.

Available resources were 285 MECU, whilst the shortfall to cover the transfers was some 188 MECU. As provided for under Article 194 § 4 of the Convention, this situation was the subject of Report from the Commission to the ACP-CE Council of Ministers (SEC 594 - 1141 final), which in this context had delegated authority to the Committee of Ambassadors.

The Committee decided, on 19.07.1994, to maintain the amount of 285 MECU for Stabex transfers for application year 1993, this being amount of resources available under the system for the application year in question. In parallel, the Commission, at its 1211th Meeting, adopted a proposal for a decision fixing the Stabex transfers to be carried out for the 1993 application year, on the basis of a global envelope of 285 MECU.

As a result of these decisions, the coverage of eligible amounts is 60,24% or 17% more than 1992.

VI.2. SYSMIN

Under Lomé III, the cumulative total of decisions taken by end 1994 amounted to 158 MECU, or 100% of the allocation provided for this instrument. Payments were 83 MECU (52% of the allocation) of which 21.5 MECU for the year 1994.

In practice, the difficulties encountered at the level of payments are often linked to the political and/or socio-economic situation of the countries concerned. In Togo, due to the political situation, a "phosphates" project of 15.7 MECU remains suspended and no payment has been made. An industrial project also for phosphates, in Senegal, is experiencing very slow implementation after market changes resulted in a substantial review of the project.

The Lomé IV Sysmin allocation is 480 MECU. At end 1994, cumulative decisions were 169 MECU (35% of the allocation), delegated appropriations and payments were respectively 84 MECU (17% of allocation) and 66 MECU (10%).

During 1994, a number of countries prepared requests for Sysmin aid - Suriname and Jamaica suffered a reduction in income from bauxite and aluminium exports, Botswana from nickel. In the course of the same year, 2 financing decisions were taken : 14 MECU for mining development in uranium and manganese in Gabon and 31 MECU for a programme of road and telecommunications infrastructure in Niger dedicated to mining activity.

VI.3. AID FOR REFUGEES

In 1994, aid for Refugees, repatriated and displaced persons was concentrated primarily in Southern and Central Africa and in the Horn of Africa i.e. in a relatively small number of areas where the situation has slowly become more stable, and on a small number of countries which have accepted a large number of refugees (Zaire, Kenya, Malawi).

Under Lomé IV (Art. 255) 10 individual actions were approved totalling 25 MECU and covering 9 ACP Countries.

Since the start of Lomé IV, 59 projects have now been approved for a total of 74.9 MECU, out of an initial budget allocation of 100 MECU.

The complementary nature of the humanitarian aid and Article 255 with the other EDF instruments (NIPs) has been evident in several situations, notably in the implementation of the rehabilitation plan for Africa where Article 255 actions amounted to 18.4 MECU in Eritrea, Ethiopia, Liberia and Zaire.

The Commission has, in addition, decided to create a "Permanent Inter Service Group" to strengthen the coordination of its aid to refugees and the link between humanitarian assistance and medium term aid, whilst at the same time reinforcing its coordination with other donors.

In the case of Somalia, which has not ratified Lomé IV, NIP resources unused under Lomé III have been mobilised for emergency aid and aid to refugees. By decision of the ACP-EC Council of Ministers (delegated to the ACP-EEC Committee of Ambassadors - doc ACP-EEC 2230/91 and doc Council 1020/82 of 18.12.92 refer) the NIPs will in due course be reconstituted from other EDF resources.

VI.4. AID TO THE LEAST DEVELOPED, LANDLOCKED COUNTRIES AND ISLAND ACP STATES (LDC/LDLIC)

Following the 1993 study on cooperation between the Community and these states, a joint report was prepared and presented to the 1994 MBABANE ACP-EC Council, which accepted the conclusions of the document, in particular those confirming that :

- ◆ the Lomé Convention recognizes of the difficult situation of the least developed, landlocked or island states;
- ◆ as far as the financial resources at the level of national indicative programmes are concerned, the Convention's provisions (especially article 238) have been wholly respected;
- ◆ the list of least developed countries drawn up by the United Nations contains 34 ACP States, of which 4 do not appear on the ACP list, but which does not include 11 countries which do appear on the ACP list.

As a result of the foregoing, the Resolution adopted by the ACP-EC Council highlighted the necessity of maintaining and strengthening efforts to help these LDLIC and requested a redefinition of LDCs to be based on criteria similar to those employed by the United Nations, so as to arrive at a consistent list which would be updated regularly and automatically in line with the United Nations system of classification.

The follow up to this Resolution is now under way, with particular attention being focused on the redefinition of LDC status.

VI.5. HEALTH PROGRAMME AND THE FIGHT AGAINST AIDS

Financial aid in support of health measures has been effected mainly through national and regional indicative programmes, and for the fight against AIDS through the "ALL ACP" element of regional funds.

This new emphasis on a sectoral approach to health as opposed to aid on a project by project basis, is designed to reinforce the matching national budgetary measures in the countries concerned : a substantial increase in funding has taken place - from 160 MECU under Lomé II, 260 MECU under Lomé III, to some 680 MECU under Lomé IV, of which 280 MECU in the form of health projects/programmes and 400 MECU as budgetary assistance.

For the fight against AIDS, the Lomé IV allocations of 50 MECU (of which 20 MECU under regional "ALL ACP" and 30 MECU under national indicative programmes has achieved a commitment rate of 56% at end 1994. Notable amongst the actions undertaken were programmes in Kenya, Senegal and the Indian Ocean region.

Considerable efforts have been made to quicken the rate of implementation of health projects and programmes in some 30 ACP Countries, with particular emphasis on the strengthening of outlying health services, supply of essential medicines, institutional structures and training.

A mid-term review of Lomé IV shows that the volume of financial aid devoted to health support and AIDS prevention amounts to almost 600 MECU, or double the amount mobilised under Lomé III.

***STRUCTURAL ADJUSTMENT
&
COUNTERPART FUNDS***

In 1994, the Community continued its support for structural adjustment, on the lines agreed since 1989 and as approved by the ACP States.

From the start of Lomé IV, until December 1994, the Commission has approved 56 decisions on structural adjustment, totalling 1.158 MECU : of this amount 708 MECU were supplied by the SAF instrument, the remainder coming from that part of the national indicative programmes set aside for the purpose.

Community aid most often takes the form of a General Import Programme, this being considered the most suitable instrument in a situation of general economic liberalisation and the most appropriate to convertible currency economies (e.g. "zone franc") - in the absence, at present, of the possibility of direct budgetary aid.

These programmes have generated Counterpart Funds, which have gradually been integrated into a macro-economic approach including financial and monetary stability, to the countries concerned. These Funds in turn, in the framework of a single and consistent budgetary policy, has been used to cover public operating costs and/or investment in support of social services essential to the population and the safeguarding of social and economic infrastructures.

The Commission has likewise continued its efforts to strengthen coordination with other donors in the Adjustment field, particularly with Member States and the Bretton Woods Institutions. To this end it has, inter alia, maintained its support to the Special Debt Programme for Sub-Saharan Africa in which participate all the main bilateral and multilateral donors.

ACCOUNTING POLICIES

VIII.1. FINANCIAL REGULATIONS

The balance sheets and statements of sources and uses of funds are drawn up in accordance with Article 66 of the Financial Regulation of 11 November 1986 applicable to the sixth EDF and Article 69 of the Financial Regulation of 29 July 1991 applicable to the seventh EDF and are submitted to the European Parliament, the Council and the Court of Auditors as provided for in Article 71 of the Financial Regulation for the seventh EDF.

VIII.2. THE ECU

Accounts are kept in ecus, an ecu being a unit defined as the following amounts of Member States currencies :

VIII.3. REVENUE

Financial contributions are normally paid either in ecus or, where Member States show due reason, in national currencies into special accounts opened with the treasuries of Member States. On the basis of the cash requirements for the execution of projects and programmes, the Commission makes transfers from the treasury accounts to operational accounts held in ecu or Member States' currencies, the conversion rate into ecus being that applicable on the date of transfer.

The total amount of contributions to a Fund is laid down in the Convention setting it up and by subsequent Council decisions. Contributions to all Funds up to and including the sixth EDF have been fully paid up : contributions for the 7th EDF were called for the first time in July 1994.

The conversion rates used for the calculation in ecus of payments made in national currencies for the purpose of projects and programmes are generally those in force on the effective date of such payments. There are some contracts involving fixed exchange rates which are an exception to this general rule.

The first, second, third and fourth EDFs were closed prior to 1991. The fifth was closed in December 1993 and its balance transferred to the seventh EDF. For the sixth and seventh EDFs there is a common treasury which is shown in the balance sheet of the sixth EDF.

Other revenue is entered in the accounts on the basis of the amounts actually collected in the course of the year.

VIII.4. EXPENDITURE

Expenditure takes into account all payment orders sent to banks for execution up to 31 December. However, in the case of expenditure made locally in APC States, only payments executed by banks by 31 December are included in the accounts ; for those payments for which information did not reach the Commission's accounting services until after the date set for the closing of the financial year, payments are based on the information received concerning the latest period prior to 31 December. The amount of payments thus not included in the 1994 accounts is not considered to be material.

Expenditure by delegations is not finally entered into the EDF accounts until validated by the Authorising Officer and the financial controller. Expenditure awaiting such verification is shown under the heading "under verification" in the balance sheet.

IX.2. INCOME AND EXPENDITURE ACCOUNT - 6th EDF

IX.2.1. The total amount of contributions to a Fund is laid down in the Convention setting it up and by subsequent Council decisions Contributions to all Funds up to and including the 6th EDF have been fully paid up : contributions for the 7th Fund were called for the first time in July 1994.

IX.2.2. Transfer from sundry receipts

By decisions in 1991 and 1992, the EDF Committee allocated 6 MECU of interest receipts to finance studies on structural adjustment. By decision of 28.06.1993, a further 2.7 MECU was allocated for audit and evaluation purposes.
