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INTRODUCTION

I. LEGAL BASIS

A – TREATY ESTABLISHING THE EUROPEAN COAL AND STEEL COMMUNITY

The ECSC Treaty was signed in Paris on 18 April 1951 and deposited in a single French original¹ in the archives of the French government. It came into force on 23 July 1952.

(a) Articles of the Treaty which concern the Consultative Committee:

Article 18

(Paragraph 1)

A Consultative Committee shall be attached to the High Authority. It shall consist of not less than 60 and not more than 84 members and shall comprise equal numbers of producers, of workers and of consumers and dealers.

(Paragraph 2)

The members of the Consultative Committee shall be appointed by the Council.

(Paragraph 3)

In the case of the producers and workers, the Council shall designate representative organizations among which it shall allocate the seats to be filled. Each organization shall be required to draw up a list containing twice as many names as there are seats allotted to it. Appointment shall be made from this list.

(Paragraph 4)

The members of the Consultative Committee shall be appointed in their personal capacity for two years. They shall not be bound by any mandate or instructions from the organizations which nominated them.

(Paragraph 5)

The Consultative Committee shall elect its chairman and officers from among its members for a term of one year. The Committee shall adopt its rules of procedures.

(Paragraph 6)

The allowances of members of the Consultative Committee shall be determined by the Council on the proposal of the High Authority.

Article 19

(Paragraph 1)

The High Authority may consult the Consultative Committee in all cases in which it considers this appropriate. It must do so whenever such consultation is prescribed by this Treaty.

(Paragraph 2)

The High Authority shall submit to the Consultative Committee the general objectives and the programmes drawn up under Article 46 and shall keep the Committee informed of the broad lines of its action under Articles 54, 65, and 66.

(Paragraph 3)

Should the High Authority consider it necessary, it may set the Consultative Committee a time-limit for the submission of its opinion. The period allowed may not be less than ten days from the date on which the chairman receives notification to this effect.

(Paragraph 4)

The Consultative Committee shall be convened by its chairman, either at the request of the High Authority or at the request of a majority of its members, for the purpose of discussing a specific question.

(Paragraph 5)

The minutes of the proceedings shall be forwarded to the High Authority and to the Council at the same time as the opinions of the Committee.

Article 78

§ 1.

§ 2. The administrative expenditure of the Community shall comprise the expenditure of the High Authority, including that relating to the functioning of the Consultative Committee, and that of the Court, the Assembly and the Council.

B – TREATY ESTABLISHING A SINGLE COUNCIL AND A SINGLE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES

The 'Merger Treaty' (MT) was signed in Brussels on 8 April 1965, in the German, French, Italian and Dutch languages. It came into force on 1 July 1967.

By this Treaty, the Commission of the European Communities and the Council took the place of the High Authority of the ECSC (MT Article 9) and the Special Council of Ministers (MT Article 1) and assumed the powers and jurisdiction previously exercised by these Institutions.

The Articles of this Treaty of interest to the Consultative Committee are as follows:

- Article 18, paragraph 6 of the ECSC Treaty is abrogated (MT Article 19) and its contents are taken up again in a

modified form in Article 6, second sentence, of the Merger Treaty. This sentence is drawn up thus: 'It (the Council) shall also, again by a modified majority, determine any payment to be made instead of remuneration.'

- Article 78 of the ECSC Treaty is abrogated (MT Article 21) and replaced by Article 78 a-f. Comparing this latter with the abrogated article, there is no change as far as the Consultative Committee is concerned.
- In the 'Protocol on the privileges and immunities of the European Communities' which forms an annex to the Merger Treaty, the following article has been taken up again in the Treaties of the EEC and of the EAEC and is equally applicable to the members of the ECSC Consultative Committee:

Article 11

Representatives of Member States taking part in the work of the institutions of the Communities, their advisers and technical experts shall, in the performance of their duties and during their travel to and from the places of meeting, enjoy the customary privileges, immunities and facilities.

This Article shall also apply to members of the advisory bodies of the Communities.

Moreover, the declaration of the Government of the Federal Republic of Germany, reproduced in Annex II to the Final Act, extends the application of the ECSC Treaty to Land Berlin.

In the application of Article 37 of the Merger Treaty, the 'Decision of the representatives of the governments of the Member States on the provisional location of certain institutions and departments of the Communities' came into force at the same time as the Treaty. In this decision, the Consultative Committee is not explicitly named, but included in the general formula:

Article 12

Subject to the preceding provisions, this decision shall not affect the provisional places of work of the institutions and departments of the European Communities, as determined by previous decisions of the Governments, nor the regrouping of departments occasioned by the establishing of a single Council and a single Commission.

C – DECISIONS OF THE COUNCIL

- a. Decision of the Council of the European Communities of 22 January 1972 on the accession of the Kingdom of Denmark, Ireland, the Kingdom of Norway and the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland to the European Coal and Steel Community.¹

Accession took effect on 1 January 1973. The Kingdom of Norway did not accede.

Act concerning the Conditions of Accession and the Adjustments to the Treaties.

The ECSC Consultative Committee

Article 22

The following shall be substituted for the first paragraph of Article 18 of the ECSC Treaty :

'A Consultative Committee shall be attached to the High Authority. It shall consist of not less than 60 and not more than 84 members and shall comprise equal numbers of producers, of workers and of consumers and dealers.'

Article 144

Upon accession, the Consultative Committee of the European Coal and Steel Community shall be enlarged by the appointment of additional members. The terms of office of the members thus appointed shall expire at the same time as those of the members in office at the time of accession.

Article 147

Adaptations to the Rules of the Committees established by the original Treaties and to their rules of procedure, necessitated by accession, shall be made as soon as possible after accession.

b. 'Observers'

- Decision relating to the nomination of people invited to participate in the work of the Consultative Committee, pursuant to special regulation.¹

On the basis of Article 18 of the Treaty :

whereas the appointments that the Council is called upon to make in one or other of the categories of members of the Consultative Committee may, according to a period of time corresponding to the length of mandate of these members as laid down by Article 18 of the Treaty, stipulate alternately candidates proposed by the representative organizations or the governments of two Member States, without prejudices to the right of the French government to propose alternately and for the same period of time a French national or a Saarlander for a place in the consumers/dealers category ;

whereas the Council may, from the beginning of a two-year period, proceed to appoint within the conditions laid down for nomination persons who, in consequence of the alternation set out in the preceding paragraph, will be named by Council decision at the beginning of the following period as Consultative Committee members for the duration of that period,

the Council

at its fourth meeting held in Luxembourg on 15 and 16 January 1953,

has appointed the following to take part in the work of the Consultative Committee, pursuant to special regulation :

Mr Carta (Italy, coal producers representative)

Mr Duchser (Luxembourg, steel users representative)

C.W. van Wingerden (Netherlands, representative of the workers' organization Nederlands Verbond van Vakverenigingen - NVV)

Mr Vogelsang (representative of the Saar processing industry)

and

has decided that the special regulation of these persons should be laid down in the internal regulations of the Consultative Committee taking into account the following principles :

- (1) they will in no circumstances have the right to vote ;
 - (2) they will be allowed to speak at the invitation of the President ;
 - (3) no account of their statements will be given in the minutes unless at the request of a majority of the members.
- By decision of the Council of 15 September 1969, the number of observers was increased from 4 to 5.¹

c. Allowances

- by decision of the Council, the allowances given for each day of meeting are adjusted from time to time either *ex officio* or at the request of the Consultative Committee.² Travel expenses are paid in addition.
- decision relating to allowances for persons invited to participate in the work of the Consultative Committee pursuant to special regulation.³

On the basis of Article 18 of the Treaty the Council at its fourth meeting held in Luxembourg on 15 and 16 January 1953 decided :

to grant to persons participating in the work of the Consultative Committee pursuant to special regulation the same allowances and travel expenses as those given to members of the Consultative Committee.

II. INTERNAL REGULATIONS

Pursuant to Article 18, paragraph 5, of the ECSC Treaty, the Consultative Committee shall have rules of procedure.

After publication in the Official Journal,¹ these internal regulations² were issued in a special edition in 1975 (Office for Official Publications No 6769). A new version of the 1968 internal regulation was called for pursuant to Article 147 of the Treaty governing the accession of the new Member States. Prior to the creation of the enlarged Consultative Committee on 1 January 1973, a provisional version was accepted at the 152nd Session of 5 December 1972 and at the 160th Session of 7 March 1973 - with the new members present - the current edition was adopted.

The internal regulations have been subject to various changes. At the 1st Session of 26 January 1953, the High Authority put forward a draft for provisional internal regulations. This was accepted with just one alteration. At the 4th Session of 22 April 1953, a special drafting sub-committee put forward a draft for a definitive version of the internal regulations. This was adopted with two alterations by the Consultative Committee and published in the Official Journal (OJ 11 of 14.8.1953).

It later became apparent that a revision was needed and a new version of the regulations was adopted at the 15th Session of the Consultative Committee on 20 December 1954 (published in OJ 3 of 31.1.1955).

An alteration to the regulations was proposed at the 16th Session of 31 January 1955 and with further changes being felt necessary, the Consultative Committee adopted the third version of its internal regulations at the 58th Session of 14 January 1960 and had it published in the Official Journal (OJ 15 of 7.3.1960).

Other alterations were decided on at the 117th Session of 14 December 1967 and the 121st Session of 1 July 1968. This led to a new edition of the regulations appearing in 1968 (published in OJ L 40 of 17.2.1969).

III. CONSULTATIVE COMMITTEE CATEGORIES

On the basis of the internal regulations adopted at the 160th Session of 7 December 1973 the term 'group' was replaced by 'category', which denotes the breakdown into:

- producers
- workers
- consumers and dealers

(cf. internal regulations, second footnote to Title I, Article 3, § 1 paragraph 2).

By letter of 1 June 1962, the High Authority authorized the holding of meetings by category and agreed to give such meetings material assistance.

PART ONE

COMPOSITION AND ORGANIZATION OF THE CONSULTATIVE COMMITTEE SINCE ITS FORMATION

I. SPECIAL DECISIONS.

1./2.12.1952, 23.12.1952, 15./16.1.1953

The Council appointed the members of the first Consultative Committee and decided on the nomination of four additional persons who would participate in the work of the Consultative Committee pursuant to special regulation.

24.2.1955

At its 18th session, the Consultative Committee set up the following three standing subcommittees:

- Subcommittee for General Objectives
- Subcommittee for Markets and Prices
- Subcommittee for Labour Problems.

15.1.1960

At its 59th session, the Consultative Committee laid down the numerical composition of its three standing subcommittees:

Subcommittee for General Objectives = 18 seats
Subcommittee for Markets and Prices }
Subcommittee for Labour Problems } = 24 seats

4.10.1960

At its 64th session, the Consultative Committee set up a fourth standing subcommittee:

- Subcommittee for Research Projects = 18 seats.

24.1.1961

At its 66th session, the Consultative Committee increased to 24 the number of seats on the Subcommittee for General Objectives.

18, 23, 24, 25.1.1967

Members of the Consultative Committee were nominated for the period 1967/69 by the Council of Ministers ten days after the mandate of the preceding Committee had expired.

(Interim period: 14 January - 24 January 1967.)

2.2.1967

At its 112th session, the Consultative Committee increased from 18 to 24 the number of seats on the Subcommittee for Research Projects.

16.1.1969

As the Council's reappointment of members was still uncertain, the Consultative Committee decided at its 124th session

- in order to avoid the work of the Commission in many areas of the ECSC coming to a standstill,
- by application of the principles and practice of public and international law, whereby the continued functioning of institutions should be ensured,

to continue functioning and to prolong the mandate of the bureau and the subcommittees until the next session.

20.3.1969

At its 125th session, the Consultative Committee decided that the bureau and the subcommittees would continue the work in progress.

15.9.1969

The Council increased from 4 to 5 the number of persons participating in the work of the Consultative Committee pursuant to special regulation.

17.10.1969

The renomination of the Consultative Committee for 1969/71 was concluded 267 days after the mandate had expired on 26 January 1969.

13.3.1970

By reference to the internal regulations and in accordance with the custom of the ECSC High Authority, the president was instructed to make available the minutes, reports, opinions and resolutions for the information of the European Parliament. ¹

12.2.1971

At its 139th session the Consultative Committee noted that, with the agreement of the President of the Commission, the Economic and Social Committee of the EEC/EAEC and the Consultative Committee would exchange documents.

15./16.4.1971

Meeting of the consumers/dealers category and the workers category took place with Commission representatives for the first time.

26.10.1971

At its 145th session, the Consultative Committee decided to continue its activities in the period between the expiry of its mandate and renomination of the Committee.

20.12.1971

At its 146th session, the Consultative Committee approved the Commission's new method of presenting the forward programmes: presentation in December for steel, in March for coal, examination of the steel programme in June, coal in September.

23.3.1972

The renomination of the Consultative Committee for 1972/74 was concluded 166 days after the mandate had expired on 16 October 1971.

5.12.1972

At its 152nd session, the Consultative Committee approved provisional new internal regulations, made necessary by the impending entry of the three new Member States.

23.1.1973

On the basis of the entry of the Kingdom of Denmark, Ireland and the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland to the European Coal and Steel Community on 1 January 1973, the Council appointed the new members from these States to the Consultative Committee.

25.1.1973

At the 153rd session, the new British, Danish and Irish members appointed on the basis of the Act of Accession participated in the Committee's work for the first time.

26.1.1973

At a formal meeting in the Luxembourg Town Hall, the Consultative Committee commemorated the 20th anniversary of its first session.

7.12.1973

At its 160th session, the Consultative Committee adopted new internal regulations (fifth edition) as required by Article 147 of the Act concerning the Conditions of Accession.

28.1.1974

At the 161st session, a delegation from the EEC/EAEC Economic and Social Committee participated in the discussion on energy problems.

25.6.1974

The renomination of the Consultative Committee for 1974/76 was concluded 94 days after the mandate had expired on 22 March 1974.
