INTRODUCTORY NOTE

- (1) Article 10 of Council Regulation (EEC) No 729/70 on the financing of the common agricultural policy requires the Commission to present to the Council and Parliament each year "a financial report on the administration of the (European Agricultural Guidance and Guarantee) Fund during the preceding financial year and, in particular, on the state of its resources and the nature of its expenditure and the conditions for achieving Community financing".

This Report covers the operations of the EAGGF Guarantee Section during the 1997 financial year.

The main task of the Guarantee Section is to finance expenditure arising under the common policy on agricultural markets and prices. Articles 2 and 3 of Regulation (EEC) No 729/70 provide that expenditure consists of refunds on exports to non-member countries, granted under the common organisation of the agricultural markets, and intervention intended to stabilise agricultural markets.

- (2) Up to and including 1986, the financial year was always the same as the calendar year. The 1987 amendments to the Community rules resulted in certain adjustments to the dates for the closing of the accounts for financial years, with the result that the period covered by EAGGF Guarantee Section expenditure no longer coincided with the calendar year. Nowadays the EAGGF financial year covers expenditure from 16 October to 15 October of the following year.

¹ The ecu is the unit of account used for the Communities' budget; all receipts and expenditure, agricultural and non-agricultural, are expressed in ecus.

Amounts in ecus are generally converted into national currencies at market rates or "budget rates". To operate smoothly, the common agricultural policy requires some stability in exchange rates between national currencies. In order, therefore, to lessen the effect on agricultural prices of any adjustments to the exchange rates, agricultural prices expressed in ecus are not converted into national currencies at the real exchange rates for the ecu but at special rates called "green rates". Hence amounts calculated in ecus under the agricultural regulations are expressed in "ECU(A)". However, for the purpose of charging the financial consequences of agricultural regulations to the budget, ecus are not converted into national currencies at the green rates but at the market or budget rates; hence amounts in ecus to be entered in the accounts are expressed in "ECU(B)".

² Although the monthly budget rates for the Belgian franc and the Luxembourg franc are identical, the average is different because it represents an average weighted according to monthly expenditure in national currency.

1. TREND IN COMMUNITY FINANCING OF PRODUCT MARKETS

1.1 Budget procedure

1.1.1 Preliminary draft budget

The Commission adopted the preliminary draft budget (PDB) on 30 April 1996. The appropriations requested for the EAGGF Guarantee Section were at the level of the agricultural guideline (ECU 41 805 million).

Uncertainty in the beef sector due to the crisis caused by bovine spongiform encephalopathy (BSE, better known as "mad cow disease") resulted in the Commission estimating the appropriations requirements at ECU 41 300 million and entering the remaining ECU 505 million in a temporary BSE budget reserve, which could be transferred to Chapter 21 "Beef" when the budgetary implications of the crisis were known.

1.1.2 The Council budget meeting on 25 July

The two sides of the Budgetary Authority agreed during the Council meeting on the budget, as part of the budgetary discipline measures being applied to the whole of the Community budget, to apply a flat-rate reduction of ECU 1 billion to the PDB appropriations. It was agreed also, with the consent of the Commission, to place in reserve in Chapter B0-40 reductions applied to the appropriations for "Financial compensation for withdrawals" (ECU 1.9 million), "Refunds for butter and butteroil (ECU 7.2 million) and "Sheep and goat premiums" (ECU 52.9 million).

The draft budget adopted by the Council ratified this agreement and brought the appropriations for heading 1 down to ECU 40 805 million.

1.1.3 Letter of amendment No 1/97

As a result of legislative changes which had taken place since the PDB was adopted, the Commission presented a first letter of amendment on 25 September 1996 to cover the reform of the fruit and vegetables sector (+ ECU 117 million), the effect of the Council Decision of 24 July 1996 on the farm prices review (+ ECU 2 million), the estimated production of olive oil for the 1995/96 marketing year and the emergency action plan to reduce beef production (ECU 1 381 million). Funding was provided by a proposed delay of some weeks in the payment of the advance on the per hectare aid for oilseeds (- ECU 1 338 million). It was proposed, lastly, to abolish the BSE reserve (- ECU 505 million).

The Commission consequently applied a reduction of ECU 216 million to the PDB, plus a further flat-rate reduction of ECU 784 million, which brought the appropriations down to the level in the draft budget (ECU 40 805 million).

1.1.4 Letter of amendment No 2/97

At the Council meeting of Agriculture Ministers on 30 October 1996 an emergency action plan was adopted containing measures over and above those proposed by the Commission (direct income support for producers and direct support for the beef sector). A second letter of amendment was therefore adopted by the Commission on 11 November 1996 to include the effects of the Council Decision.

The additional expenditure of ECU 504 million was offset partly by early payment of the 1996 premiums for suckler cows and male bovine animals (- ECU 230 million)

Requirements had risen to ECU 41 863 million, representing a ECU 58 million overrun of the agricultural guideline. As in the case of the first letter of amendment, the Commission applied a flat-rate reduction of ECU 1 billion, which, together with the entry in the budget of only ECU 442 million as additional income aid for producers, meant that the requirements could be kept at the level of the proposed appropriations.

1.1.5 Continuation of the budget procedure

Parliament was prepared to accept a single reading of the letter of amendment on condition, mainly, that the beef promotion measures were given extra funds (+ ECU 20 million). The Council agreed to this request and ECU 20 million were entered in Chapter B0-40 "Provisions", which now had a total allocation of ECU 72 million, following the ECU 10 million reduction in the reserve for sheep premiums. This Chapter consequently included:

- ECU 1.9 million for certain measures in the fruit and vegetables sector;
- ECU 7.2 million for measures in the milk and milk products sector;
- ECU 42.9 million for premiums for sheep and goats;
- ECU 20.0 million for promotional measures.

The budget was adopted finally subject to these amendments.

1.2 Implementation of the budget

1.2.1 As indicated above, the appropriations originally allocated to the EAGGF Guarantee Section in 1997 amounted to **ECU 40 805 million** (not including the monetary reserve of ECU 500 million).

Total expenditure came to **ECU 40 423.0 million**, i.e. 99.1% of the budget allocation (95.8% in 1996). This represented a 2.4% increase, up from the figure of ECU 39 107.8 million in 1996.

At the end of 1997 ECU 382.0 million remained unused, i.e. less than 1% of the allocation. This balance falls to ECU 286.0 million leaving aside the appropriations in Chapter B0-40 and a transfer of ECU 44 million to the monetary reserve.

1.2.2 Plant products (Chapters 10 to 18) showed an overrun of the budget allocation of some ECU 1.15 billion, due mainly to arable crops and more precisely to the absence of a Council decision to shift the date for payment of the advances for oilseeds for 1997/98 to 1998, which generated additional expenditure of ECU 1.3 billion.

Pigmeat too showed an overrun (ECU 478.8 million as against ECU 124.2 million in 1996). The significant overspend in this sector was due to the substantial expenditure which the Commission had to incur, amounting to some ECU 400 million, in compensating producers for market intervention required as a result of health measures to control a particularly virulent outbreak of classical swine fever in the Netherlands.

1.2.3 Expenditure fell, by contrast, for several product groups, which could be offset against those where there was an overrun. This applied in the case of beef (ECU 870 million down due to the drop both in production and in the level of imports which allowed the market situation to be restored more rapidly), milk (ECU 545 million recovered for quota overruns in the two previous milk years), sheepmeat (favourable trend in market prices on account of the BSE crisis), sugar and fruit and vegetables (delay in implementing the reform).

Major savings were achieved (ECU 244 million) due to the favourable ECU/dollar rate in 1997. Their breakdown is as follows:

– Cereals	ECU 161 million
– Sugar	ECU 43 million
– Rice	ECU 5 million
– Non-Annex II products	ECU 29 million
– Remote islands and regions	ECU 6 million


Savings in excess of the neutral margin of ECU 200 million (ECU 44 million) were transferred to the monetary reserve at the end of the year.

1.2.4 In 1997 four transfers were made between chapters, one from the reserve for "Provisions" (ECU 20 million for measures to promote beef as a result of the BSE crisis) and one of ECU 44 million to the monetary reserve.

1.2.5 Payments amounting to ECU 251.9 million were made from the non-automatic carryovers from 1996 to 1997 and of ECU 30.7 million from the automatic carryovers from the 1996 budget to that for 1997.


1.2.6 The share of EAGGF Guarantee Section expenditure in the general European Union budget for 1997 (ECU 87 650 million) was 46.12%. This does not differ greatly from that for the preceding years (see Graph 1).


1.3 When the breakdown of expenditure by economic type of measure is examined (Annexes 5, 6 and 7 and 25c), the following trends can be seen:

- spending on **export refunds**, having declined significantly in recent years, stabilised at ECU 5 884 million in 1997 as against ECU 5 705 million in 1996; it thus now accounts for 14.6% of total EAGGF Guarantee Section expenditure;
- **intervention** spending in 1997 came to ECU 34 539 million, which is ECU 2 584 million more than in 1996. This consists mainly of storage expenditure and compensatory aid (production, processing and marketing aid). The structure of this expenditure has not changed significantly compared with 1996 and the other years since the reform and the return to more balanced markets: expenditure on **storage** was slightly up (ECU 1 597 million as against ECU 1 381 million in 1996) in particular as a result of the crisis in the beef sector (ECU 750 million), a further rise in **compensatory aid** (ECU 32 095 million compared with ECU 29 483 million in 1996 and ECU 24 490 million in 1995) which, as in 1996, consisted largely of exceptional income support measures for cattle producers. Spending on accompanying measures was up also (ECU 2 065 million as against ECU 1 853 million in 1996 and ECU 832 million in 1995).
- As in the other years since the reform, **direct aid paid to producers** represents, in terms of the structure of expenditure, the major share of EAGGF Guarantee Section expenditure, amounting to ECU 28 680 million (71%) with the remainder going on **market support measures**.


1.4 This trend is reflected in the **sector-by-sector breakdown** (not including the outcome of the accounts clearance operation) (Annexes 4 and 25b).

Arable crops, which now brings together 4 former expenditure headings (cereals, oilseeds, protein plants and set-aside), accounted for 42.2% of overall spending. It is followed by **beef and veal** (15.9%, compared with 16.6% in 1996) and milk products (7.5%, down on 1996, when it stood at 8.9% of spending). See Graph 2 for the shares of the other product groups.


1.5 Breakdown by Member State (Graph 3)

France is still the main recipient of Guarantee Section expenditure at ECU 9 128 million or over 22% of overall spending. It is trailed by Germany (ECU 5 775 million), Italy (ECU 5 025 million) and Spain (ECU 4 585 million).

In the third year following accession (the second in which the new Member States received full funding), Austria received ECU 859 million (ECU 1 212 million in 1996), Finland ECU 568 million (ECU 648 million in 1996) and Sweden ECU 745 million (ECU 622 million in 1996).

Annex 2b shows expenditure by chapter and by Member State (summary of Annex 2) and Annex 25a developments since 1981 (in amounts and shares).

2. CASH POSITION AND MANAGEMENT OF APPROPRIATIONS

- 2.1** The 1997 budget was adopted on 18 December 1996 and provided for appropriations amounting to ECU 40 805.0 million for the EAGGF Guarantee Section, including ECU 72 million entered in Chapter B0-40 "Provisions".

There was no supplementary and amending budget in 1997.

- 2.2** The management of the appropriations is summarised in the table below:

- 2.3** The Commission adopted 13 decisions granting advances in 1997, 12 of these being of the regular kind and one extraordinary to adjust advances granted so as to match total spending for the year.
- 2.4** Pursuant to Article 13 of Council Decision 94/729/EC on budgetary discipline, which allows the Commission to reduce or provisionally suspend monthly advances to the Member States where declarations of expenditure or information submitted by the latter do not enable the Commission to establish whether funds can be committed in conformity with Community rules, the Commission decided to:

- reduce advances by ECU 25.0 million in respect of expenditure incurred in excess of the regulatory ceilings and after the cut-off dates;
- reduce advances by ECU 195.8 million as a result of failure to collect the additional levy on milk for 1995/96;
- reduce advances by ECU 103.3 million as a result of failure to collect the additional levy on milk for 1996/97;
- reduce advances by ECU 4.0 million as a result of failure to collect securities covering unused quantities of alcohol in public storage under Tender No 8;
- reduce advances by ECU 0.4 million as a result of certain expenditure being declared before the regulatory date for payment of the amounts in question;
- suspend advances amounting to ECU 10.5 million.

The latter involved expenditure totalling ECU 9.2 million declared by the Member States under Council Regulation (EC) No 723/97, for which the Regulation permitting it to be charged to the Community budget was only adopted in December 1997, and expenditure amounting to ECU 1.3 million declared by the United Kingdom under Regulation (EC) No 1757/96 for which payments had to be suspended until all the eligibility criteria were met. The total amount of ECU 10.5 million committed in 1997 will be payable at the beginning of the 1998 financial year, once the necessary conditions are met.

In addition, payments amounting to ECU 41.9 million were suspended pending the arrival of information for determining the quantity of alcohol in storage in Italy.

3. TIGHTENING OF CONTROLS

Since 1995, the Unit for the Coordination of Fraud Prevention (UCLAF) has been responsible for the practical fieldwork relating to fraud-prevention investigations. The EAGGF's work therefore has concentrated on stepping up controls in the areas outlined below.

Under the Integrated System, a large number of inspection visits were conducted in connection with the clearance of accounts operation in all Member States, with the object also of reviewing the introduction and organisation of the System as well as the administrative and on-the-spot checks.

Community financing for the System ended in 1996 and the balance for that year was paid in 1997 with almost all the available appropriations being taken up. Generally speaking, the five components of the System, i.e. the database, identification of parcels of agricultural land, livestock identification and registration, aid applications and systems of control, were in place. The date by which the Integrated System is to be fully in place in the three new Member States is set at 1 January 1998.

Olive oil inspection agencies continued their work in accordance with their schedule of activities, stepping up checks on production aid and forwarding particulars of the proposed penalties to the respective Member States, which have not, however, adequately followed up the proposals.

Community part-financing introduced by Regulation (EEC) No 307/91, to step up controls on certain expenditure to be borne by the EAGGF Guarantee Section, expired at the end of the 1995 budget year for the first 12 Member States and at the end of 1997 for the three new ones. In view of the scale of the financial interests at stake, the Commission considered that Member States should continue to receive funding for controls, based on long-term objectives, to be carried out by the Member States. The Council approved Regulation (EC) No 723/97 of 22 April containing provisions to this effect.

Because of the delay in bringing this instrument and its implementing Regulation (Commission Regulation (EC) No 1780/97) into force, the Community financial contribution was set by the Commission in Regulation (EC) No 2436/97 on 9 December 1997.

Lastly, the arrangements for monitoring by remote sensing common to all Member States taking part in the Integrated System (12 Member States took part in the monitoring in 1997, i.e. all with the exception of Austria, Luxembourg and Sweden) make possible a large proportion of the checks on declarations of area. The unit cost of remote sensing has fallen due to improvements in technique and the skill of contractors, the increase in the area checked and, more recently, the availability of IACS databases and is currently comparable with that of conventional checks.

In 1997, photointerpretation made it possible for around 79% on average of applications to be accepted, with 20% rejected and 1% of analyses not completed.

4. CLEARANCE OF ACCOUNTS

In 1997 the Commission adopted four decisions on the clearance of EAGGF Guarantee Section accounts.

On 23 April 1997 it took a first decision (97/333/EC) on the clearance of accounts for the 1993 financial year and on 30 July 1997 finalised the procedure for 1993 by Decision 97/608/EC.

Furthermore, in compliance with the new rules on accounts clearance, the Commission adopted the first decision (97/316/EC) on the clearance of accounts for the 1996 financial year on 5 May 1997.

The procedure for 1996 was subsequently finalised by Decision 97/609/EC of 30 July 1997.

Other work carried out in 1997 essentially related to the following areas:

- finalising the clearance of accounts procedure for the 1994 financial year up to the drafting of the summary report (Doc VI/7421/97);

- arranging discussions with all the Member States on the results of the inspection visits concerning the 1995 financial year;
- participating in the work of Parliament's Committee on Budgetary Control in connection with the discharge in respect of the 1995 budget;
- the opinion of the Court of Auditors on the clearance of accounts decision for the 1993 financial year;
- the Court of Auditors' statement of assurance covering EAGGF Guarantee Section expenditure for the 1996 financial year;
- preparing and carrying out inspection visits for the purposes of the clearance of the accounts for the 1996 and 1997 financial years;
- contributing to the reform of the common organisation of the markets in olive oil and tobacco and to the reform of the CAP (Agenda 2000);
- active cooperation with the Conciliation Body in supplying it with information to deal with requests from the Member States in connection with the clearance of accounts for the 1993 and 1994 financial years.

A working document outlining the work of the EAGGF Guarantee Section during the 1997 financial year is available in English, French and German.

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NOTE TO THE READER

1. The budget nomenclature is changed each year to take account of developments in the common agricultural policy and its financing. Thus, in 1994, some expenditure was not booked in the same chapter as in 1993:

As a result, there has been a change in the way expenditure is grouped in the following summary tables (Annexes 3, 4, 8 and 25b).

In order to ensure that comparisons with past data are not distorted, i.e. to avoid cases where there is a large difference in the amount of expenditure from one year to the next in a given sector simply as a result of a change of grouping, the following principle is followed:

- the most recent nomenclature is used (1997 in this report),
- the aggregates for previous years are recalculated in accordance with this nomenclature.

This means, however, that some subtotals in this report differ from those found in reports published in previous years.

For example: 1990 expenditure under Chapter 10 (Cereals and rice) amounted to ECU 3 884.6 million (Annex 3 to the Twenty-Third Financial Report, page 145). This is "real" expenditure - in the accounting sense of the term - in accordance with the nomenclature applicable in 1990, which grouped expenditure in a different way from the current nomenclature.

To make comparisons possible, 1990 expenditure under Chapter 10 (Arable Crops) when recalculated comes to ECU 7 834.5 million in this Report (Annex 3).

No important changes have been made to the budget nomenclature for 1997. The changes are mainly intended to improve budget transparency.

To that end and in order to show clearly the charging of amounts recovered, penalties and interests collected, securities impounded and amounts withheld by the Member States for Community budget contributions to court expenses incurred with a view to recovering amounts unduly paid, a suitable structure now exists within each relevant chapter.

In addition, as some measures have been repealed for some years now, the budget headings concerned have been deleted (co-responsibility levy, ACAs, MCAs); agri-monetary aid, which was booked with MCAs in Chapter 32 in 1995, is now entered in Chapter 39 (Other measures).

2. Totals or subtotals of expenditure in the following tables sometimes differ by ECU 0.1 million from the amount obtained arithmetically by adding the lines or columns. This difference is due to rounding up and down. The totals are generally expressed in ECU million while the calculations are carried out using amounts in ecus.

- 2. Commission Regulation (EC) 896/97 of 20 May 1997 amending and rectifying Regulation (EC) 1663/95 laying down detailed rules for the application of Regulation (EEC) 729/70 regarding the procedure for the clearance of the accounts of the EAGGF Guarantee Section (OJ L 128 , 21.5.1997, p. 8)**

The purpose of the Regulation is to adapt two provisions of Regulation (EC) 1663/95 to prevent expenditure which has been reduced or suspended from being financed prematurely or provisionally.

- 3. Commission Regulation (EC) 1281/97 of 2 July 1997 fixing depreciation percentages to be applied when agricultural products are bought-in, for the 1998 financial year (OJ L 175, 3.7.1997, p. 10)**

The Regulation fixes the coefficients to be applied by intervention agencies to monthly buying-in values for the purpose of establishing depreciation amounts.

- 4. Commission Regulation (EC) 1392/97 of 18 July 1997 amending Regulation (EEC) 3597/90 on the accounting rules for intervention measures involving the buying-in, storage and sale of agricultural products by intervention agencies (OJ L 190, 19.7.1997, p. 22)**

The purpose of the Regulation is to provide for the possibility of increasing the value at which missing quantities and quantities which do not meet the conditions laid down for storage are to be reimbursed to the EAGGF, in particular when the market price is higher than the intervention price or the intervention buying-in price.

The Decision governs the non-recognition, reduction or suspension, subject to further scrutiny, of part of the expenditure declared by certain Member States in respect of the 1996 financial year.
