

Development of a comprehensive implementation track for the new Mental Health Act in Albania

Beneficiary country Albania

Summary

In 1995, a Phare project on health legislation in Albania, initiated by the NSPH, has resulted in compilation of a Mental Health Act which was adopted by the parliament in 1996. This Act is a major step forward in the care of and attitude to mental health in Albania and it needs assistance in its implementation. Aim of this project is the comprehensive enactment of the Mental Health Act (1996). This will be achieved through:

- the creation of two pilot primary mental health care centres
- the assistance to the establishment of a patient stream,
- the review of patients by a joint Dutch Albanian team,
- training in human rights, patients rights and mental health procedures etc.



The project aims to consolidate the local NGO by reinforcing its institutional capacities, to train operators in the socio-sanitary field and to improve the health and social conditions of women. This will be achieved through:

- training local NGO staff in social, psychological and sanitary assistance and in ways of spreading this information,
- training local operators
- courses on reproduction issues as well as on organising small enterprises for dB's,
- the production of manuals, information and didactic materials.

Summary

For the last few months, Bosnia is facing the problem of the Opcinska Organiza recurrence of Tuberculosis, especially in the region of Zenica. Movimento Sviluppo e Pace was made aware of this problem by "Dom Sdravlja" and later on by the Health Department of Zenica. The main objective of the project is to train health and medical staff which will allow them to implement a system of control of Tuberculosis in order to diagnose at least 80% of expected cases of infection per year. It will be achieved through:

- · fund raising,
- staff recruitment,
- the purchase of equipment,
- training of a local doctor and local (para-)medical staff, as of the technical and laboratory staff,
- seminars for social and cultural operators,
- treatment standardisation,
- and the implementation of an information campaign and production of leaflets.

Due to current economic collapse, there are no rehabilitation and social services available in Varna for children with handicaps who usually live in distressed environment under tremendous social, economic and emotional pressure. This results in marginalisation of families, leading to isolation of handicapped children. The project aims to create a model working Centre in Varna which provides daycare and rehabilitation for children with physical and mental disabilities from an early age. It will be based on interdisciplinary assessment of each child. Several activities will be carried out as for examples:

Other contraception methods or fertility regulations are needed. Summary

Several epidemiological studies in Estonia have demonstrated that Estonia lies in the high risk area for MS, in the Fennoscandian focus with the prevalence rate 55 per 100,000. Disabled persons are now a neglected minority as a heritage of the former historical era. Aim is to create a Social Support System that concentrates and develops expertise about Multiple Sclerosis (MS) management and rehabilitation in order to prevent the early mortality of PwMS (2/3 of which are female) due to inadequate treatment of the illness.

It will be achieved through:

- training sessions to specialised care professionals,
- management and administration courses to administratif staff included in the project,
- · demonstration material for MS Patients,
- creation of a 6 beds in-patients rehabilitation unit in Tartu's main clinic,
