The 1996 Phare Partnership Programme

The Phare Partnership Programme is an NGO co-financing programme initiated by the European Commission. It fits within the wider framework of the European Community (EC) Phare programme, which goal is to support the process of economic and social reform in the central and eastern European countries (CEECs).

The overall objective of the 1996 Partnership programme is to provide financial support for initiatives that encourage local economic and socio-economic development. The programme aims more specifically:

- to promote sustainable local development;
- to strenghthen decentralised and non-profit organisations contributions and initiatives;
- to encourage cross-country co-operation and sustainable partnerships among NPOs based in the European Union and in the central and eastern European countries (CEECs);
- to encourage the development of civil society.

The 1996 Partnership programme supports in particular projects operating within one or more of the following areas of activity:

- Local and Regional Development;
- Business and Enterprise Development;
- Human Resource Development and Training
- Socio-Economic Development.

A number of the selected projects presented in this compendium are currently running¹ and are financed through the 1996 Phare Partnership budget (global allocation for the 1996 programme: 10 million ECU).

The information contained is based on data available on 31 August 1998.

The following tables illustrate the evolution of the programme since 1995, its second year of running. Please note that several countries can benefit from one selected project and that several organisations co-operate together within one selected project. These added figures may not correspond to the numbers of selected projects per country.

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Albanian vocational education and training

Summary

The project will build on the previously successful development of competence based vocational education and training to pilot a national system of assessment, verification, accreditation and awards for the Albanian Agricultural and Horticultural Industries. Education and training will be developed at craft and technician levels for young people preparing to enter the land based industries. Also practical training programs will be developed for farmers and their families involved in the production processing marketing of crops and livestock and the management and control of agricultural and horticultural businesses.

The project is a youth business trust which will provide micro-credit through a revolving loan scheme to young unemployed and disadvantaged entrepreneurs (18-30 years). This main operations phase follows three years of feasibility and establishment and will include the active training phase of the Business Advisers recruited from the private sector. Training, in partnership with the corporate sector, will provide individual advise and guidance to each young entrepreneur supported. The young people will be selected from those trained through Eletpalya Alapitvany (Live Wire in Hungary) which assists young people to consider self-employment and to develop their business ideas. MIVA and Eletpalya Alapitvany have together colocated in the Youth Enterprise Centre at the Business Polytechnic, Budapest to make a success of this project. An in-depth evaluation will result in a model defined for national replication.
