Proposal for a COUNCIL REGULATION (EEC)<br>implementing certain provisions of the Agreement between the Community and Czechoslovakia on trade in industrial products

(presented by the Commission)

## EXPLANATORY MEMORANDTOM

1. An Agreement on trade in industrial products between the European Economic Commanity and the Czeahorlovak Sootalist Repoblic was algned in Brussels an 19 December 1988. ${ }^{1}$
2. Annexes I, II and III A to the Agreement contain Iists of products identified and classified a0cording to the 1987 NDNEXB nomenclature. In an exchange of letters conoerning the Combined Nomenciature, 2.180 annexed to the Agreement, the Community undertakes to replace these annexers with others based on the Combined Nomenalature (CN).
3. In addition, under Articles 4 and 5 of the Agreement, the Commanty has undertaken to abolish quantitative restrictions on imports into certain regions of the Community of certain produots, as listed in Annex II to the Agreement, and also to suspend the application of quantitative restrictions on imports into regions of the Comunity of certain products, as iisted in Annex. III to the Agreenent, on the terms and conditions specified therein.
4. Under Conmissicm Decisions Nos $C(88) 1478$ of 27 July $1888^{2}$ and $C(88) 2245$ of 28 November 1988,3 the Ccumunity has already adopted the measures referred to in Annex III B to the Agreement and some of the measures referred to in Annex II A to the Agreement. The attached proposal, therefore, provides solely for the abolition or suspension of quantitative restrictions on imports of the other produots Iisted in those Amexes.
5. These liberalization measures mean that imports into the Comunity of any of the products Iisted in Annex II A originating in Czechonslovaicia will be free of all quantitative restriotions. Those productis fall therefore within the scope of Counoil Regulaticn (EDC) No 1785/824 on coumon miles for imports from state-trading countries and are added to the Amex to that Regulation.
6. This is the aim of this Coumission proposel.

## implementing certain provisions of the Agreement between the Community and Czechoslovakia on trade in industrial products

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community, and in particular Article 113 thereof,

Having regard to the proposal from the Commission,

Whereas an Afreement on trade in industrial products between the European Economic Community and the Czechoslovak Sooialist Republic, hereinafter referred to as the "Agreement", was signed in Brussels on 19 December 1988;1

Whereas Annexes I, II and III A to that Agreement contain lists of products identified and classified according to the 1987 NIMEXS nomenolature; whereas, in the exchange of letters concerning the Combined Nomenclature, also amexed to the Agreement, the Community undertakes to modify the NIMEXE nomenclature, replacing it with the Combined Nomenclature (CN) codes; whereas Annex III B to the Agreement already identifies products according to the Combined Nomenclature, although for practical reasons all the annexes to the Agreement should be reproduced together;

Whereas, under Article 4 of the Agreement, the Community undertakes to eliminate quantitative restrictions on imports of certain products into

[^1]certain regions of the Community, as listed in Amex II to the Agreement; whereas, moreover, under Article 5 of the Agreement, the Community undertakes to suspend the application of quantitative restrictions on imports into regions of the Community of certain products, as listed in Annex III, on the terms and conditions specified therein; whereas, under Commission Decisions Nos C(88)1478 of 27 July $1988^{1}$ and C(88)2245 of 28 November $1988^{2}$ the Community has already adopted both the measures referred to in Annex III B to the Agreement and same of the measures referred to in Annex II $A$ to the Agreement; whereas the quantitative restrictions on imports of the other products listed in Amex II A (reproduced as Annex IV to this Regulation) should therefore be abolished;

Whereas this will mean that imports into the Community of any of the products listed in Annex II A will be free of all quantitative restrictions; whereas these products can therefore be covered by Counail Regulation (EEC) No 1765/82 on common rules for imports from State-trading countries, ${ }^{3}$

## HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATIOA:

## Article 1

Anexxes I, II and III to the Agreement between the European Economic Community and the Czechoslovak Socialist Republic on trade in industrial products are hereby replaced by the corresponding Amexes to this Regulation.

## Article 2

1. The quantitative restrictions on the release for free circulation in the Community of the products listed in Annex II B are hereby abolished in the Member States specified in the Annex with regard to those products.

2. The application of quantitative restrictions on the release for free airculation in the Communty of products listed in Annex III A originating in Czechoslovakia is hereby suspended in France on the terms and conditions specified in that Annex.
3. The quantitative restrictions on the release for free circulation in the Community of products listed in Amex IV originating in Czechoslovakia are hereby abolished throughout the Community.

## Article 3

Imports into the Community of the products listed in Annex II A originating in Czechoslovakia shaill be subject to Council Regulation (EESC) No 1768/82. These products shall be added to the Annex to that Regulation.

## Article 4

This Regulation shall enter into force on the thind day following that of its publication in the Official Journal of the European Communities.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
