Extending the provisional anti-dumping duty on imports of Potassium Permanganate originating in Czechoslovakia

(presented by the Commission)

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

- 1. By Regulation (EEC) No. 2535/89¹ the Commission imposed a provisional anti-dumping duty on imports into the Community of potassium permanganate originating in Czechoslovakia.
- 2. Due to the need for a thorough check of discrepancies appearing between import figures declared by the Czechosiovakian exporter and those contained in Community statistics, the examination of the facts could not be completed within three months after the imposition of the provisional duty.
- 3. Consequently, the Commission considers that it is necessary to extend the period of validity of the provisonal duty for a further period of two months. The Czechoslovakian exporter concerned was informed in this respect and did not object.
- 4. On the basis of Article 11(5) of Council Regulation (EEC) No. 2423/88 the Commission submits to the Council, therefore, a proposal for a Council Regulation extending the provisonal anti-dumping duty on imports of potassium permanganate originating in Czechoslovakia, by a further period of two months.

Extending the provisional anti-dumping duty on imports of Potassium Permanganate originating in Czechoslovakia

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No. 2423/88 of 11 July 1988 on protection against dumped or subsidized imports from countries not members of the European Economic Community¹, and in particular Article 11 thereof.

Having regard to the proposal from the Commission,

Whereas:

By Regulation (EEC) No. 2535/89², the Commission imposed a provisonal anti-dumping duty on imports of potassium permanganate originating in Czechoslovakia:

The examination of the facts has not yet been completed and the Commission has informed the Czechoslovakian exporter concerned of its intention to propose an extension of the period of validity of the provisional duty for a further period of two months. The Czechoslovakian exporter concerned did not object.

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Article 1

The provisonal anti-dumping duty on imports of potassium permanganate originating in Czechoslovakia, imposed by Regulation (EEC) No. 2535/89, is hereby extended for a further period of two months.

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on the day following its publication in the Official Journal of the European Communities.

Without prejudice to Article 11 of Regulation (EEC) No. 2423/88 and to any other decision taken by the Council, it shall apply until the entry into force of an act of the Council adopting definitive measures.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
