EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

- (1) Commission Regulation (EEC) No 707/89 imposed a provisional antidumping duty on imports of calcium-metal originating in the People's Republic of China or the Soviet Union.
- (2) The examination of the facts has not yet been completed.
- (3) The Commission has informed the Chinese and the Soviet exporters concerned of its intention to extend the period of validity of the provisional duty for a further period not exceeding two months. The exporters did not object.
- (4) Therefore, on the basis of Article 11, paragraph 5 of Council Regulation (EEC) No 2423/88, the Commission submits to the Council a proposal of Council Regulation extending for a further period not exceeding two months the provisional anti-dumping duty imposed on imports of calcium-metal originating in the People's Republic of China or the Soviet Union.

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 2423/88 of 11 July 1988 on protection against dumped or subsidised imports from countries not members of the European Community¹, and in particular Article 11 thereof.

Having regard to the proposal from the Commission,

Whereas by Regulation (EEC) No 707/89², the Commission imposed a provisional anti-dumping duty on imports of calcium metal originating in the People's Republic of China and the Soviet Union,

Whereas the examination of the facts has not yet been completed and the Commission has informed the Chinese and the Soviet exporters concerned of its intention to propose one extension of the period of validity of the provisional duty for a further period not exceeding two months, whereas the exporters did not object,

HAD ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Article 1

The provisional anti-dumping duty on imports of calcium metal originating in the People's Republic of China and the Soviet Union, imposed by Regulation (EEC) No 707/89, is hereby extended for a period not exceeding two months.

Without prejudice to Article 11 of Regulation (EEC) No 2423/88 and to any other decision taken by the Council, it shall apply until the entry into force of an act of the Council adopting definitive measures.

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on the day following its publication in the Official Journal of the European Communities.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
