EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

At its plenary part-session on 25 May 1989 Parliament debated the Commission's proposal for a Council Directive on procedures for harmonizing the programmes for the reduction and eventual elimination of the pollution caused by waste from the titanium dioxide industry (1).

It also debated the second amendment to the same proposal, as submitted by the General Secretariat of the Council on 26 January 1989(2).

After discussion the proposal under "Cooperation procedure, second consultation, first reading", Parliament approved the Commission's second amendment to the proposal for a Directive, agreed that the legal base chosen by the Commission was correct and rejected the position of the Council favouring Article 130S of the EEC Treaty.

Parliament adopted a series of amendments to the Council's text (3).

Amendments 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8 and 10 are exactly the wording set out in the second amendment to the Commission's proposal.

As regards amendments 11 and 12, the Commission accepts them both, as proposed by Parliament.
