EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

The aim of the two proposals for Regulations attached is to extend the scope of the provisions for applying the tax for the benefit of the European Communities to the officials and temporary staff affected by the special termination-of-service measures introduced as a result of the accession of Austria, Sweden and Finland and to add them to the categories of official and other servant of the European Communities to whom the provisions of the second paragraph of Article 13 of the Protocol on the Privileges and Immunities of the Communities apply.

The proposed amendments to Regulation (EEC, Euratom, ECSC) No 260/68 and Regulation (Euratom, ECSC, EEC) 549/69 are identical to those made on the occasion of the adoption of previous regulations introducing special measures to terminate the service of officials and temporary staff of the European Communities.

Both Regulations will apply from the date on which the termination-of-service measures referred to above enter into force.

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Article 1

The following subparagraphs are added to Article 2 of Regulation (Euratom, ECSC, EEC) No 549/69:

- "(n) those entitled to the allowance provided for in the event of termination of service under Article 4 of Regulation (EC, Euratom, ECSC) No 2688/95,
- those entitled to the allowance provided for in the event of termination of service under Article 4 of Regulation (EC, Euratom, ECSC) No 2689/95".

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on the day following its publication in the Official Journal of the European Communities.

It shall apply from the date on which the respective Regulations referred to in subparagraphs (n) and (o) of Article 1 enter into force.

- those entitled to the allowance for termination of service under Article 4 of Regulation (EC, Euratom, ECSC) No 2689/95."

It shall apply from the date on which the respective Regulations referred to in the two indents of Article 1 enter into force.

That article of the Protocol provides that "Officials and other servants of the Communities shall be liable to a tax for the benefit of the Communities on salaries, wages and emoluments paid to them by the Communities. They shall be exempt from national taxes on salaries, wages and emoluments paid to them by the Communities."
