EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

Under the Agreement on fisheries between Sweden and Norway of 9 December 1976, Sweden enjoys, free of charge, certain fishing rights within the Norwegian exclusive economic zone south of 62°00'N.

In the autumn of 1995, consultations were held between the Community, on behalf of Sweden, and Norway in order to specify the relevant fishing rights for 1996. It was not possible to conclude these consultations because of Norway's insistence on too drastic a reduction in Swedish catch quotas. Therefore, Council Regulation (EC) No 3076/95 had to leave open the allocation of the corresponding catch quotas to Sweden.

Consultations continued in 1996 and proved to be protracted. They eventually led to a successful conclusion, on 5 July 1996, by way of which an agreement was reached on the following catch quotas to be allocated to Sweden in 1996:

•	Cod:	460 tonnes)

The objective of this proposal is to implement, at Community level, these agreed catch quotas and to amend Council Regulation (EC) No 3076/95 accordingly.

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN UNION,

having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Community,

having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 3760/92 of 20 December 1992 establishing a Community system for fisheries and aquaculture⁽¹⁾ as amended by the Act of Accession of Austria, Finland and Sweden, and, in particular, Article 8(4) thereof,

having regard to the proposal from the Commission,

Whereas Council Regulation (EC) No 3076/95⁽²⁾ had to leave open the allocation of certain catch quotas to which Sweden is entitled under the Agreement on fisheries between the Kingdom of Sweden and the Kingdom of Norway of 9 December 1976;

Whereas, in accordance with the procedure provided for in the aforementioned Agreement on fisheries of 9 December 1976, the Community, on behalf of Sweden, continued to hold consultations with Norway concerning the relevant fishing rights for 1996;

Whereas these consultations have been concluded and, consequently, it is now necessary to implement the agreed measures,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Article 1

Annex II to Council Regulation (EC) No 3076/95 shall be replaced by the Annex to this Regulation.

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on the day following its publication in the Official Journal of the European Communities.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
