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AMENDED PROPOSALS FOR

COUNCIL REGULATIONS (EC)

amending the basic regulations of certain decentralised Community agencies

(presented by the Commission pursuant to Article 189 a (2) of the EC-Treaty)

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

1. On 16 October 1997,¹ the Commission approved a proposal for the amendment of the basic regulations of nine decentralised Community agencies with a view to subjecting them to the highest levels of public accountability and openness.

The European Parliament gave its opinion on the proposal at its part-session of 9-13 March, voting through a number of amendments, some of which the Commission can accept.²

The Economic and Social Committee was consulted in accordance with Article 130s of the Treaty on the amendment to Council Regulation (EC) No 1210/90 of 7 May 1990, on the setting up of the European Environment Agency and the European Environment Information and Observation Network,³ and gave its approval at its meeting of 28-29 January 1998.

- 2. To summarise, those amendments which the Commission can approve relate to the granting of discharge to the decentralised Community agencies and to the Commission's Financial Controller acting as the agencies' financial controller.
- 3. However, the Commission cannot support Parliament's amendments on own resources or on any surplus agency revenues.

The Commission cannot accept the incorporation of all of the agencies' revenues into the Community budget and the right to evaluate their level of fees. The Commission wishes to preserve the management autonomy of the agencies and considers that there is no need to change the system of setting fees or charges for certain agencies.

In accordance with Article 189a (2) of the EC Treaty, therefore, the Commission has drawn up the following amended proposals.

AMENDED PROPOSAL

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Article 1

Article 12(11) of Regulation (EC) No 1035/97 is replaced by the following:

"11. The European Parliament shall, on the recommendation of the Management Board, give a discharge to the Director of the Centre in respect of the implementation of the budget."

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on the third day following its publication in the Official Journal of the European Communities.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
