Commission communication to the Council:

European Development Fund Timetable for calling in contributions for 1978 and 1979

COM (78) 660 final

Under Article 3, as regards the third EDF, and Article 7, as regards the fourth EDF, of the Internal Agreement on the financing and administration of Community aid the Commission must draw up and transmit to the Council each year estimates of EDF commitments to be entered into during the following budget year and, on this basis, prepare the timetable for calling in contributions, taking into account the EDF's cash requirements.

The purpose of these contributions is to replenish the EDF's cash resources in order to enable it to make disbursements.

Accordingly, the purpose of this Communication is to assess the EDF's cash requirements for 1979 and hence the amount of the contributions.

The tables annexed to this Communication give:

- (a) an estimate of commitments in 1979 under the four EDFs in operation;
- (b) an estimate of total disbursements for 1979;
- (c) hence, the timetable for calling in the Member States' contributions to the third and fourth EDFs for 1979;
- (d) the statement of contributions at 31 December 1979.

It is proposed that the following sums be called in for 1979:

- 1. for the third EDF, from the six Member States signatory to the second Yaoundé Convention, 20 000 000 EUA;
- 2. for the fourth EDF, from the nine Member States signatory to the Lomé Convention. 400 000 000 EUA.

In accordance with Article 2 of the Financial Regulation, it is proposed that each of these contributions be called for in two equal instalments, the first payable on 10 January 1979 and the second on 2 July 1979.

In view of the cash situation registered in 1978, it is proposed that the contributions due for July 1978 (second 1978 instalment) for the third and fourth EDFs (8.5 million EUA + 139 million EUA = total of 147.5 million EUA) be cancelled.

This Communication sets out below the detailed grounds for these proposals in the following order:

- III. Estimated expenditure for 1979;
 - IV. Replenishment of the EDF's cash resources.

I. Trend of expenditure and present situation

At 15 September 1978 cash in hand, according to the figures sent by the Delegates twice a month by telex, stood at 230 million EUA.

As regards commitments, the situation is as follows (at 31 August 1978):

<u>first EDF</u>: committed in full; <u>second EDF</u>: committed in full;

third EDF: 16 million EUA still to be committed.

The percentage of disbursements under the first three funds was over 97% for the first Fund, 98% for the second Fund and 80% for the third Fund (in its eighth year of operation).

Taken as a whole, the three Funds account for expenditure to the tune of 2 032 million EUA out of the 2 216 million EUA allocated to them; overall expenditure is therefore 91.7% of the sum allocated.

The situation as regards the fourth Fund, which commenced operations on 1 April 1976, according to the book entries at 31 August 1978 is shown in the table below:

II. Estimated expenditure for the current year (1978)

Expenditure under the first EDF for the first eight months was approximately 1 000 000 EUA; this is not expected to exceed 2 million EUA for the whole year.

Expenditure under the second EDF amounted to 4 million EUA over the same period; for the final four months it could be some 2 million EUA, making a total of 6 million EUA for the whole year.

Expenditure for the first eight months under the third EDF amounted to 48 million EUA; it is estimated that for the whole year it will rise to some 70 million EUA.

III. Estimated expenditure for 1979

First EDF - The resources of this Fund have virtually been used up: estimated expenditure 2 million EUA.

Second EDF - Financing decisions involve commitments amounting to 730 million EUA;
disbursements amount to 718 million EUA;
balance to be paid is thus 12 million EUA.

Taking this into account, and in view of the trend in past years, it can be estimated that expenditure for 1979 will be of the order of 5 million EUA.

Third EDF - Financing decisions involve commitments amounting to 889 million EUA;
disbursements amount to only 746 million EUA;
hence the balance to be paid out is 143 million EUA;
Expenditure for 1979 could therefore reasonably be put at 65 million EUA.

Total expenditure for the first three Funds should therefore amount to around 72 million EUA.

Fourth EDF - Operations under the fourth Fund seem to have started up at last. With the customary reservations, it can reasonably be estimated that the volume of expenditure in 1979 will show an average growth rate of 20% over that of 1978.

The following details seem called for in this connection:

At the end of August 1978 the Commission had taken financing decisions (i.e. approved commitments) involving an aggregate amount of 1 378 million EUA (of which 76 million for exceptional aid and 154 million for Stabex).

Given the schedule of projects to be submitted to the EDF Committee by 31 December, total commitments at the end of 1978 under the fourth EDF will stand at around 1 585 million EUA.

In view of the foregoing and commitments requiring rapid disbursements, the amounts to be paid out for 1979 can be broken down as follows:
