THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROFEAN CERTIFITIES?

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 729/70 of 21 April 1970 on the

financing of the common aggicultural policy (1), as last amended by Regulation (EEC)

No 2788/72 (2), and in particular Article 3 (2) thereof.

Having regard to the proposal from the Commission,

Whereas the Annex to Council Regulation (EEC) No 2824/72 of 28 December 1972 laying down general rules for financing interventions by the Gurantee Section of the European Agricultural Guidance and Guarantee Fund (3), as last amended by Regulation 'EEC) No 709/76 (4), lists the measures which are interventions intended to stabilize agricultural markets for the purposes of Article 3 (1) of Regulation (EEC) No 729/70; whereas, since the said Annex was last amended, certains measures have been adopted which, as regards the financing of the common agricultural policy, should be considered as interventions intended to stabilize agricultural markets; whereas the said Annex should therefore be amended;

Whereas the codification of Regulations in certain sectors requies that their numbers should be altered in the said Annex; whereas the said Annex has been amended several times since 1972, namel by Council Regulations Nos 526/73 (1), 3536/73 (2), 330/74 (3) 2683/74 (4) and 1175/75 (5); whereas the whole Annex, including the latest amendments, should therefore be consolidated;

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION :

Sole Article

The Annex to Regulation (EEC) No 2824/72 is hereby replaced by the Annex hereto.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member states.
