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COMMUNICATION FROM THE COMMISSION TO THE COUNCIL

on the final estimate for the 1974/75 wine-growing year

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Pursuant to Article 3 (3) of Regulation No 24, "for each wine-growing year, and for the first time before 16 April 1971, the Commission shall provide the Council with final estimates of Community resources and uses in the preceding wine-growing year".

The final estimate for the 1974/75 wine-growing year is annexed hereto.

Its main features compared to the 1973/74 estimate are:

- that total production has fallen by about 10 million hectolitres;
- that imports from non-member countries have, fallen by 1.9 million hectolitres;
- that processing has increased by about 12 million hectolitres;
- that losses have remained the same;
- that end of year stocks are down by about 6 million hectolitres.

At 160 205 000 hectolitres for the Community, the autumn 1974 harvest is well above total home use, without taking account of the distillation measures pursuant to Article 7 of Regulation (EEC) No 816/70.

There was a big harvest in all the producing countries, and generally it was of good quality.

Total home use showed an increase at 148 938 000 hectolitres, without taking account of the above mentioned distillation measures.
