## COMMTNI CATION FROM THE GOMMTSSTON TO THE COUNCIL

relating to the definitive balance-sheet for the $1972 / 73$ wine-growing year

Artiole 3(3) of Regulation No 24 stipulates that, for each wine-growing year and for the first time before 16 April 1971, "the Commission must provide the Council with a definitive balance-sheet of Community resources and the use made of these resources in the previous winemgrowing year".

The definitive balance-sheet for the $1972 / 1973$ winemgrowing year is attached to this commanication.

It shows thet as compared with 1971/72:

- total production dropped by 5 million hectolitres;
- imports from third countries increased by approximately 5 million hectolitres, due on one hand to the poor harvest and on the other hand to the enlargement of the Community,
- 2 million hectolitres less were processed,
- losses were reduced by some 0.1 million hectolitres,
- end-of-year stocks were down by 11 million hectolitres.

The Community harvest in Autum 1972 was at a low level with 127.720 million hectolitres.

All producer Member States had poor harvests.
The quality of the harvest was generally better than that of the previous wine-ngrowing year.

Total home utilization increased to 143 \%700 million hectolitres, of which 140.316 million hectolitres was accounted for by the Community as originally constituted and 3.384 million hectolitres by the new Member States.
