EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

The present modified proposal for a Council Regulation (EEC) on Quotas 1980 is presented in conformity with Article 149 paragraph 2 of the Treaty.

It takes account of modifications which have had to be made in recent months to the quota calculations as a result of

- (i) increases in the shares of the total allowable catches of certain species available to the Community which occurred since the Commission submitted its original proposals (COM(80) 452 final of 16 July 1980) to the Council;
- (ii) revisions in the data which formed the basis of the proposal of 16 July; and
- (iii) revisions in the method of calculating the quota figures.

The latter revisions are the most recent and concern the way in which figures for jurisdictional losses of Member States are used in the quota calculations.

The present modified proposal subsumes in the Annex the amendments already made to the Commission's original proposal of 1 October 1980 (COM(80) 575 final) and of 16 October, 1980 (COM(80) 617 final).
