# Recommendation for a COUNCIL REGULATION (EEC)

on the conclusion of the Additional Protocol to the Agreement between the European Economic Community and Hong Kong on trade in textile products consequent on the accession of the Hellenic Republic to the Community

(submitted to the Council by the Commission)

COM(82) 559 final

- 1. Under the Act of Accession of Greece to the European Communities (Article 123), it was agreed that the Community would negotiate protocols of adaptation to the bilateral agreements on trade in textile products between the Community and third countries.
- 2. By Decision of 1 August 1980 the Council authorised the Commission to open negotiations with Hong Kong to conclude an agreement on such adaptation.
- 3. In accordance with that Council Decision and in consultation with the Article 113 Committee, the Commission conducted negotiations with Hong Kong from October 1980 to February 1981

Following the negotiations, a draft Protocol was drawn up extending the terms of the original bilateral agreement to trade between Hong Kong and the enlarged Community, thus (inter alia)

- increasing the existing voluntary restraint levels on exports to the whole Community to new agreed levels,
- extending the existing consultation procedures whereby new voluntary restraint measures may be introduced for categories of products not at present subject to limitation, where certain thresholds are exceeded, in respect of both the whole Community and Greece.

The Heads of Delegation initialled the text of the draft Protocol on 9 February 1981 having noted it correctly represented the results of the negotiations.

4. The Protocol has already been implemented by Commission Regulation (EEC)

No 2342 /81 of 74 june 1981 (1) amending the existing régime established

by Regulation (EEC) 3059/78, and replacing, in respect of imports into

Greece, the provisional measures taken unde founcil Regulation (EEC)

No 3554/80 of 22 December 1980 (2).

- 5. The Commission considers that the draft Protocol embodies an arrangement which is acceptable to the Community. It therefore recommends that the Council:
  - (i) approve the Protocol by adopting the Regulation, the draft of which is annexed hereto;
  - (ii) pending approval of the Protocol, take the necessary decisions in connection with the signing thereof.

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Article 1

The Additional Protocol to the Agreement between the European Leonomic Community and Hang Rong

on trade in textile products,

Article 2

The President of the Council shall give the notification provided for in Article 4 of the Additional Protecol (1).

#### Article 3

This Regulation shall enter into force on the day following its publication in the Official Journal of the European Communities.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.

CONSIDERING the accession of the Hellenic Republic to the European Communities on 1 January 1981

HAVING REGARD to the Agreement between the European Economic Community and Hong Kong signed on 12 February 1980 and hereafter called the "Agreement",

HAVE DECIDED to determine by common accord the adjustments and transitional measures to the Agreement consequent on the accession of the Hellenic Republic to the European Economic Community

and TO CONCLUDE THIS PROTOCOL &

#### Article 1

The text of the Agreement as hereby amended, including its annexes and protocols and exchange of letters, forming an integral part thereof, shall be drawn up in Greek and that text shall be authentic in the same way as the original texts.

#### Article 2

The Agreement shall be amended as follows :

- 1. The 1981 and 1982 limits set out in Annex II shall be increased to the quantities set out in the Annex hereto, and
- 2. Article 6 paragraph 8 and 9 shall be replaced by the following :
  - 8. The Community undertakes not to invoke the provisions of paragraph 2 of this Article before the level of export authorizations for textile products mentioned in paragraph 1 in any category exceeds, in relation to 102 % of the preceding year's total imports into the territories within which the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community applied at 31 December 1980 of products in that category, the following rates:
  - for categories of products in Group I, 0.2 %
  - for categories of products in Group II, 1%
  - for categories of products in Group III, IV or V, 3%
  - 9. The Community further undertakes not to invoke the provisions of this Article on a regional basis before the level of export authorizations for textile products mentioned in paragraph 1 in any category exceeds, in relation to the amounts calculated by the fraction 100/102 (one hundred divided by one hundred and two)of the rates referred to in Paragraph 8, the following regional percentages:

3. For the purpose of calculating "the preceding year's total imports" referred to in 2. above, both of 1980 and 1981, imports from the Hellenic Republic shall be those recorded in 1980.

### Article 3

The Annex to this Protocol forms an integral part thereof. This Protocol forms an integral part of the Agreement.

## Article 4

This Protocol shall be approved by the contracting Parties in accordance with their own procedures. It shall enter into force on 1st January 1981, provided that the contracting Parties have notified each other before that date that the procedures necessary to this end have been completed. After this date the Protocol shall enter into force on the first day of the second month following such notification.

#### Article 5

This Protocol is drawn up in duplicate, in the Danish, Dutch, English, French, German, Greek and Italian Languages, each of these texts being equally authentic.
