Report on the management of the quantities of frozen beef intended for processing which may be imported on special conditions as provided for in the Council Estimate 82/55/EEC.

When the Council Estimate of 1 February 1982, concerning beef and veal intended for the processing industry for the period 1 January to 31 December 1982 (82/55/EEC), (1) was adopted the Commission undertook to present a report to the Council before 31 July 1982.

The information at present available to the Commission during the period 1 January to 31 July 1982, which covers the first three quarterly periods in 1982, shows that:

- Requests for licences for the import of frozen beef for the manufacture of preserved food as specified in Article 14(1)(a) of Regulation (EEC) No 805/68 (2) (system a), for which a zero import levy was applicable, were heavily oversubscribed on each occasion;
- Likewise requests for licences for the import of frozen beef for the manufacture of preserved food specified in Article 14(1)(b) of Regulation (EEC) No 805/68 (system b) for which a partial import levy of 45 % was applicable, the total quantity available to be allocated; enabled
- For the last quarter in 1982 the quantity of beef which may be imported is equivalent to 13,500 tonnes bone-in (6.750 tonnes system a and 6,750 tonnes system b).

The Commission considers that, as the licences issued under both system a and system b have not fallen below the quantity provided for, no other action is called for. .
