Proposal for a COUNCIL REGULATION (EEC)

deleting certain products from the Annex to Council Regulation (EEC) No 2603/69 of 20 December 1969 establishing common rules for exports

(submitted to the Council by the Commission)

Explanatory Statement

By Regulation (EEC) No. 2603/69 of 20 December 1969⁽¹⁾, the Council of the European Communities established common rules for exports.

Article 10 of the said Regulation provided that, until such time as a common commercial policy in respect of the products set out in the Annex (the negative list) should be put into effect, the principle of freedom of export from the Community would not apply to them.

However, a number of these products have been liberalised by the Member State (Germany) which, up to now, had been alone in maintaining quantitative restrictions. Exports of these products are, therefore, liberalised in the entire Community and there is no reason to fear that the reintroduction of quantitative restrictions will be necessary in the near future.

In the circumstances, the Commission considers that the application, at Community level, of the principle of freedom of export of these products would be justified. It proposes, therefore, that they should be deleted from the Annex to Council Regulation (EEC) NO. 2603/69.

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES.

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community; Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No. 2603/69 of 20 December 1969 establishing common rules for exports (1) and in particular Article 10 thereof;

Having regard to the Proposal for the Commission,

Whereas exports of certain products included in the Annex to Council Regulation (EEC) NO. 2603/69 have been liberalised by the Member State which up to now has been alone in maintaining quantitative restrictions and it is now possible to apply, at Community level, the principle of freedom of export to those products;

HAS ADOPTED THIS RECULATION:

Article 1

The products relating to the undermentioned tariff positions are hereby deleted from the Annex to Regulation (EEC) No. 2603/69:
