PROPOSAL FOR A REGULATION (EEC) OF THE COUNCIL

amending Regulation 146/67/EEC laying down rules for calculating the levy and the sluice-gate price for poultrymeat

(submitted to the Council by the Commission)

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

I. General remarks:

The common organization of the market in poultrymeat, established in Council Regulation No 123/67/EEC, involves mainly a system of levies and sluice-gate prices calculated principally on the basis of prices of feed grain.

In order to establish the amount of the levy and the level of the sluice-gate price for each product, the quantities of feed grain required for the production of 1 kg of the product and the other costs of production and marketing should be specified.

Council Regulation No 146/67/EEC laid down the rules to be observed in making these calculations and fixed the processing coefficients (quantity of grain) and the standard amounts (other costs) for whole slaughtered poultry and chicks.

Developments in production and marketing techniques and changes in production, processing and market costs, especially in recent months, cannot be ignored.

If is the Commission's view that the time has come to present to the Council proposals for altering the factors for calculating the levy and the sluice-gate price. These proposals are not of a kind likely to provoke distumbance in trade. Their adoption could demonstrate the desire of Member States to bring the Community rules into line with the technical and commercial realities of agricultural production.

Since grain prices on the world market during the reference period (November 1973/April 1974) were higher than the average threshold prices for 1974/1975, amount (a) disappears for the period 1 August 1974 - 31 October 1974. Levies given in columns 4 and 5 are limited to component (b) valid from 1 August 1974 (equal to 7 % of sluice-gate prices 1 May 1973 - 30 April 1974).

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THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES.

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community; Having regard to Council Regulation 123/67/EEC on the common organization of the market in poultrymeat, as last amended by the Act concerning the Conditions of Accession and the Adjustments to the Treaties2, and in particular Articles 4 par. 3 and 7 par. 5 thereof;

Having regard to the proposal from the Commission:

Whereas Council Regulation No 146/67/EEC3 of 21 June 1967 laying down rules for calculating the levy and the sluice-gate price for poultrymeat, as amended by Regulation (EEC) No 988/734 specified, inter alia:

- (i) the quantities of feed grains required for the production in the Community and in third countries of one kilogramme of slaughtered poultry according to kind and of one chick of any kind.
- (ii) the composition of the mixtures of cereals making up the quantities required for the production of slaughtered poultry and of chicks.
- (iii) the standard amount expressing other feeding costs and overhead costs of production and marketing of one kilogramme of slaughtered poultry according to kind and of one chick of any kind;

Whereas technical developments and price changes have led to significant alterations in the data used for fixing the above items; whereas some of those items should therefore be amended;

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:
