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Readers of the 'Newsletter' since its beginning twelve years ago have been able to observe through its pages how the Common Agricultural Policy has been devised, elaborated and applied.

As the first issue appeared in November 1963 we feel that it is now a suitable moment to present a chronological and analytical index of all the items we have published during the last twelve years - from November 1963 to November 1975.

This long period can be divided into three stages: the first of these, the transition stage, runs until 1967. The second covers the establishment of the single market, the introduction of the common organization of markets, the launching of the structural policy and the arrival of monetary problems.

The last of the three is the stage of reflection and includes the '1973-1978 Memorandum' and the 'Stocktaking of the Common Agricultural Policy' which represent a study in depth of the present situation of European agriculture, and of its achievements and prospects.
