

COMMISSION GRANTS FOR UNIVERSITY RESEARCH DOUBLED

The Commission announced 24 new research grants for work being carried out in universities on different aspects of European affairs. In previous years only twelve grants have been awarded. Three grants were given to researchers in U.K. universities:

- Miss Elizabeth Carstairs, Centre of European Governmental Studies at the University of Edinburgh, for research in "Critical analysis of the systems of merger controls in the EEC and in the United Kingdom with reference to other national systems".
- Mr. Michael Ford, Faculty of Law, University of Cambridge, for research in "Conflicts of law and labour law within the EEC, with particular reference to Britain and France".
- Mr. Michael Leigh, University of Sussex, for research in "The impact of political succession on Community participation".

Of the 24 grants, all went to universities within the European Community, with the exception of two grants made to American institutes.
