Weekly Timetable of Community Activities - No 15/75

On Monday and Tuesday, April 28 and 29, there will be a meeting of the Council of Ministers of Agriculture in Brussels.

The postponed Council of Ministers on Energy meeting may now take place on May 13, though this is not yet certain.

In the following week, there will be a Foreign Affairs Council on May 5 - 6 in Brussels. The Development Council for May 13 is still uncertain. On May 20 there will be a Council of Finance Ministers followed by one on Agriculture on May 26-27.

FLASHBACK:

An ORC poll published in the Evening Standard produced the following result in relation to voting on the referendum:

60% YES	28% NO	12% DON'T KNOW

It was decided by the House of Commons that referendum votes are to be counted on a county basis, except for Scotland and Northern Ireland, which will be counted on a regional basis.

At a Council meeting in Luxembourg, the British Government agreed to the Dutch compromise plan for parliamentary control of the Regional Fund. The European Parliament has recorded its refusal of this solution.
