June Council Meetings, Luxembourg :

Monday and Tuesday, June 23 and 24 : Ministers of Agriculture

Tuesday, June 24 : Foreign Ministers

Thursday, June 26 : Ministers of Energy and Research.

On the agenda of the Foreign Affairs Council figure preparations for the UN Extraordinary Session for developing countries; discussion of the Commission's proposals for a raw materials policy in their respect; and preparations for the EEC Heads of Government meeting in July.

Energy ministers are expected to discuss the Commission's latest proposals for encouraging and financing investments in indigenous energy resources (including "minimum protection level" - floor price - for petroleum improts).

FLASHBACK

The Council's adoption on June 16 of the Directives on mutual recognition of medical qualifications and administrative coordination of medical activities opened the way for the exercise of doctors' right of establishment and freedom to provide services anywhere in the Community. These should become effective within 18 months of the Directives' publication in the EEC Official Journal.

The Social Affairs Council postponed the deadline for the implementation of the 40-hour week and 4 weeks' paid annual holiday to the end of 1978. The Commission's proposal was for their implementation by the end of this year.
