REGIONAL FUND AWARDS GRANTS OF 109 MUA
THIRD 1976 ALLOCATION

The Commission has approved a further instalment of grants, totalling 108 mua, from the European Regional Development Fund. These grants relate to 471 investment projects in five Member Countries, with a total investment cost of 898 mua. This brings the total amount committed since the Regional Fund made its first grants in October 1975 to 568 mua.

Of the new allocation of grants, 28.2 mua are related to 155 projects in the industrial, handicraft and service sectors, and 80.6 mua to 316 infrastructures projects, including 16.9 mua for 195 rural infrastructure projects in less favoured agricultural areas. The attached tables give, for the five Member Countries concerned, a regional breakdown of the grants made under the new allocation, plus cumulative figures for all grants since October 1975. For the other countries cumulative figures are given on national basis only.

The projects include a number of important infrastructure developments, of which the largest by far concerns the modernisation of the port of Cagliari in Sardinia, the total investment cost of which is 258 mua. The grant of 36.6 mua for this project is the biggest single grant yet approved by the Regional Fund. The other major infrastructure projects approved in this allocation are :

- Sicily: improved water supply for industrial use in the regions of Agrigento, Caltanissetta and Palermo (Regional Fund grant: 3 mua)
- Greenland: construction of a new power station at Godthåb (1 mua)
- Scotland: construction of a new reservoir (Castle Hill Dam) and water treatment works at Glendevon, N.E. Fife (300,000 ua.)

- Wales: development of a new industrial estate at Bobw Vale, involving land preparation, roads on and leading to the estate, and gas, electricity, water and sewage services (675,000 ua.).

Payments are made to the national governments pari passu with their own expenditure in connection with the projects concerned. The governments are entitled, in accordance with the Fund regulation,⁺⁾ to pass on the money to the investor, or to treat it as partial reimbursement of their own expenditure. In the latter event, the additional resources thus made available to them are to be used for other regional development purposes, so that the total regional development effort is increased correspondingly.

EUROPEAN REGIONAL DEVELOPMENT FUND

(Third allocation of grants, 1976)

Grants to the United Kingdom : £ 9.7 million

Attached is a list of the projects in respect of which grants have been approved. The money will be paid to the United Kingdom Government in step with the Government's own expenditure on the projects concerned.

As far as industrial projects are concerned, the Community grants now announced represent a Fund contribution of up to half the cost of the assistance given to individual projects by the United Kingdom Government.

European Regional Development Fund grants are not paid to the companies concerned in addition to the assistance they receive from the Government because it is not the purpose of the Fund to enable the individual investor systematically to get an additional grant from the Community over and above what he would have received from the Government in any case. If that were to be done generally, it would simply mean that the same number of investments was undertaken but selected individual companies each got more. The main objective of the Fund is rather to enable a larger volume of regional industrial development, and associated investment in infrastructure, to take place than would have been possible if the Government had had to rely on national resources alone.

The Community grants towards infrastructure projects are passed on in full to the local and other public authorities concerned, thus reducing the amount they have to borrow to finance the investment in question.

Applications for grants in respect of projects with a total investment cost exceeding 10 million units of account (approximately £ 4.1 million) are dealt with separately. Smaller projects are grouped in a global application and a grant is made in respect of the whole group. It is not possible to give a figure for the aid granted to individual projects in this second category.

The United Kingdom had previously received £ 56.4 million of grants from the Regional Fund since October 1975. The present allocation brings the total grants to £ 66.1 million.
