

TWO-DAY CONFERENCE ON

"DOING BUSINESS WITH EUROPE AFTER THE CANADA/U.S. TRADE DEAL"

European and Canadian businessmen, academics and civil servants will meet in Montreal on December 4-5, 1987, at the Château Champlain Hotel for two days of panel discussions and talks on "Doing Business with Europe after the Canada/U.S. Trade Deal".

Sponsored by the Canadian Council for European Affairs, in cooperation with the Delegation of the Commission of the European Communities in Ottawa, the symposium will focus on the international trading environment, the impact of the Canada/U.S. trade deal on relations between Canada and the European Community, the prospects for bilateral trade and investment, and the question: where do we go from here? The symposium will thus deal with topical subjects of importance to Canada and her trading partners, including the European Community.
