EEC RESEARCH GRANTS TO U.K.

The Commission has just approved 3 research projects and 1 research study in Britain to be given financial aid from the EEC. Brief details follow:

Beneficiary: International Research and Development Co Ltd (IRD)

Project: The aim of the research is to design a heat pump system for

operation at condensing temperatures of 120° C, using as the prime mover a gas engine with waste heat recovery in the exhaust and water jacket eventually from the oil cooler. This programme

consists of two stages:

1. specification and design of the system with an economic analysis

2. procurement, installation and tests.
