FLASHBACK

Official EEC butter stocks amounted to 172,000 tonnes in August, after falling 10,000 tonnes from a stock of 182,000 tonnes when the new marketing year began in May. Newspaper reports of rising intervention stocks were wrong; stocks represent just over one month's consumption.

Quantities of butter held by the private trade have been increasing, as one expects during the summer months of milk production. They were up from 67,000 tonnes in May to 245,000 tonnes in August, but this is a normal seasonal increase. This butter will be marketed during the coming months.
