> EUROPE's "THIRD WORLD" COMMISSIONER VISITS U.S.

Claude Cheysson, the member of the European Commission responsible for EC relations with the developing countries, arrives in Washington Tuesday night (August 7) for three days of talks with US officials on aid and trade policies toward the Third World in general, and Africa in particular.

On Wednesday, Conmissioner Cheysson will take part in inter-agency discussions with top officials from the White House, the State Department, the Treasury, the Department of Agriculture, and U.S.A.I.D., under the chairmanship of Undersecretary of State for Economic Affairs William J. Casey. He will also meet with World Bank President Robert S. McNamara.

On Thursday, Cheysson will have talks with Ambassador William D. Eberle, President Nixon's Special Trade Representative and with officials of the Council for Internationa1 Economic Policy and other Government Agencies. Thursday evening, the Commissioner will address the Overseas Development Council.

Cheysson will hold a press conference Friday morning at 10:00 a.m. at the office of the Delegation of the European Communities. He returns to Europe on Friday.
