#### EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

1. In its Decision of 28 July 1982<sup>1)</sup>, the Council granted support of 25 977 600 ECU for 36 technological development projects in the hydrocarbons sector.

The amount allocated in support was covered by appropriations available in the 1982 Budget for Community projects, a total of 26 050 323 ECU.

- 2. Because there were not sufficient resources available to meet all applications for financial support, the Council was forced to hold over consideration of three projects until the 1983 financial year and to limit its support for four other projects to the preliminary stages only.
- 3. After implementation of Chapter 70 of the 1982 Budget, it emerged that resources were sitll available and that additional amounts could be transferred to other Items within that same Chapter.

The Commission proposes that the Council assign some of these appropriations to the projects which were held over until the following financial year or which received only partial support in 1982.

The amount of additional support which the Commission proposes the Council grant for these projects is 2 739 054 ECU for the period from 1982 to 1984.

4. When decisions are taken on the allocation of support for the next financial year, account will be taken of the fact that these amounts have been distributed between the various projects.

THE COUNCIL IS THEREFORE ASKED TO ADOPT THE FOLLOWING DECISION:

Whereas by its Decision of 28 July 1982 on the granting of support for Community projects in the hydrocarbons sector, the Council granted 25 977 600 ECU for the carrying out of 36 technological development projects,

Whereas the scope of this Decision should be extended in order to allow other projects to benefit from Community support,

### HAS DECIDED AS FOLLOWS:

# SOLE ARTICLE

The projects contained in the Annex to this Decision shall be added to the list of projects contained in the Annex to the Decision of 28 July 1982. Support for a total amount of 2 739 054 ECU shall be granted for these projects for the period from 1982 to 1984.

# 4. Description of the measure

Granting 36 Community undercakings financial aid for use on a sjects in the hydrocarbons sector.

## Objective

To promote technological development directly related to the activities of prospection for, and exploitation, transport and storage of hydrocarbons likely to increase the security of the Community's supplies in hydrocarbons.

# 6. Justification of the project

Because of the technical risks and the financial burden involved in carrying out the technical development projects, they would not be carried out or would have to be postponed (thus considerably prejudicing the security of hydrocarbons supplies) unless the Community provided financial support.

#### 8. Type of control to be applied

- 8.1. There is to be no control by Member States. The authorising department and Financial Control will carry out regular on-the-spot checks on documents, and will follow the completion of the projects by means of the technical and financial reports which the undertakings are required to send in regularly.
- 8.2. The Commission is to present an annual report to the Council on the state of progress of each project and the sums committed in carrying it out; the Commission also has to submit an annual report to the Council and the European Parliament on the implementation of Regulation NO. 3056/73.
