Introduction

This Supplement to the Bulletin of the European Community offers the reader, as far as official publication allows, a birds-eye view of measures adopted by the EEC Institutions for aligning national legislation since 1 January 1958 when the Treaty came into force, up to 1 January 1972. It follows on Supplements which came out in 1965 with a similar purpose and of which the most recent was No. 6/1970 covering the twelve years of transition (1958-1969).

Since any survey entails the sharpest possible definition of its object and in the case in point alignment of legislation is a concept capable of several meanings, the selected one should be spelled out. Here "measures for alignment" embrace all Directives, Decisions, Recommendations and Opinions which the EEC Institutions have transmitted to all Member States and which fulfill the two following conditions:

- Their purpose is to see that the internal law of each Member State carries binding provisions which conform with the common rules;
- They are not intended to remove restrictions on the free movement of goods, persons, services and capital;

This summary, therefore, does not cover the Regulations for they are Acts which are directly applicable and which are but occasionally a common source of law for all the national legislations. In excluding Directives, Decisions, Recommendations and Opinions which are aimed at removing restrictions, a distinction is made, clearly seen in the EEC Treaty, between provisions for pulling all Member States law into line with certain basic principles inspired by the prohibition of national preference in all its forms and provisions slanted towards harmonization which although envisaged by the Treaty has not yet been given precise content or form.

Also regarded as alignment measures are the Agreements made by Member States between themselves to attain the objectives of the Treaty. Of course, these Agreements which do not revise the EEC Treaty are not strictly speaking Community law. Even if they are drawn up and signed within the Community Institutions, this does not change their character. Nevertheless, they must be mentioned, firstly because of their end result and secondly because their applicability is usually subject to the passing of an internal Act, thus making them analogous to a Directive or Recommendation.

The Directives, Decisions, Recommendations and Agreements which derive from alignment of national legislation thus defined have been noted not only when adopted, formulated or ratified but equally when they emerge as proposals from the Commission to the Council or as signed by the contracting parties.

This list also includes additional data:

- Resolutions, Communications, Programmes or Decisions which do not involve a target have been quoted when the Acts announce, prepare or facilitate alignment of national legislation;
- Through footnotes, an attempt has been made to prevent misinterpretations which can arise in any tabulations;
- In the right of establishment and the freedom to offer services, there is a relationship between the many measures for alignment of legislation and those for removal of restrictions. The latter are therefore tabulated in appendix in similar categories to those followed in Chap. XII of the list which covers alignment measures.

⁴ Besides the Recommendations quoted, the Commission also adopted three others based on Arts. 27 and 155 of the Treaty. Their provisions have later been incorporated in Regulation 950/68 of 27 June 1968 on the Common Customs Tariff (OJ L 172 of 22 July 1968) ultimately amended by Regulation 1/72 of 20 December 1971 (OJ L 1 of 1 January 1972). They, therefore, have no further purpose. 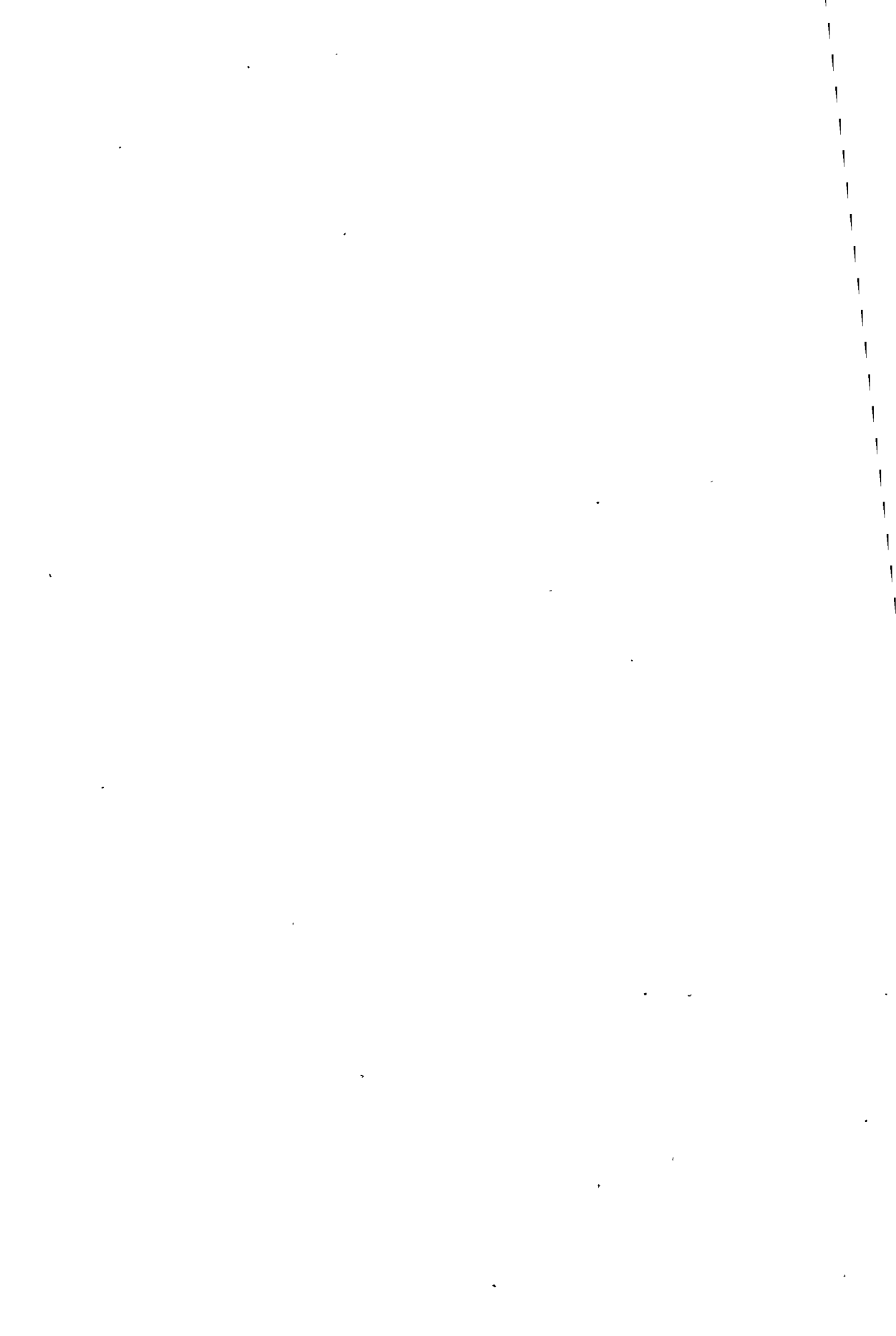
