Subject : Community economic and social policy

1. Does the Commission share the opinion of the undersigned that there is an urgent need for new coordinated measures at European and national level to boost economic activity so as to combat unemployment?
2. Does the Commission not consider that these measures should be based on a more flexible concept of growth, attaching more importance to quality, thus allowing a more balanced development of the Member States and the regions of Europe?
3. To meet the requirements of the current situation should these measures not act on both supply and demand?
4. Should this policy not be closely coordinated with the major industrialized countries, particularly the United States and Japan? Should it not be combined with measures to increase demand in the developing countries?
