MOTION FOR A RESOLUTION

pursuant to Rule 47 of the Rules of Procedure

on the compatibility of the Republic of Ireland's neutral status and the provisions of the Treaty of Accession 1972

## The European Parliament,

- A. Having regard to the Treaty of Accession of January 1972 of which Ireland is a signatory and the provisions of the EEC Treaty,
- B. Bearing in mind the recent statement by the Irish Prime Minister, Mr. Haughey, that Ireland was a neutral state after a Council decision to maintain economic sanctions against Argentina,
- C. Recognising that other countries of Europe who have historically maintained a neutral stance have felt unable to join the Community in order not to undermine such neutral status.
- 1. Calls upon the Government of the Republic of Ireland to confirm formally that it maintains neutral status and to advise the Council and the Commission accordingly;
- 2. Requests the Council and the Commission on receipt of formal notification from the Republic of Ireland that it is a neutral state to consider as to whether Ireland can honour its commitments under the Treaties.
