MOTION FOR A RESOLUTION

tabled by Mrs FUILLET

for entry in the register

pursuant to Rule 49 of the Rules of Procedure

on the absence of a deadline for Council decisions on
reports adopted by the European Parliament

The European Parliament,

- A - whereas the European Community institutions do not always function efficiently,
 - B - whereas relations between Council and Parliament are of undeniable significance in this regard,
 - C - recalling that Council decisions on reports adopted by the European Parliament are not subject to any deadline,
 - D - stressing the importance of simplifying and accelerating this procedure,
1. Urges that the Council be required to act on reports adopted by the European Parliament within a certain period of time;
 2. Requests that the time allowed be twelve months from the date on which the report was forwarded and that after this time, the Council's failure to act be regarded as tacit approval of the conclusions contained in the reports;
 3. Instructs its President to forward this resolution to the Commission and the Council.
