Communication from the High Authority of the European Coal and Steel Community to Associations of Enterprises coming under the Community's jurisdiction

(Article 48 of the Treaty)

In a letter addressed to the President of the Consultative Committee on June 13, 1956, the High Authority requested the Committee to proceed to the consultations prescribed in Article 55, 2 of the Treaty

—regarding the advisability of setting aside funds derived from the levy provided for in Article 50 of the Treaty to finance a new experimental scheme for the building of workers' houses.

The Associations of Enterprises coming under the jurisdiction of the Community have, under Article 48, second paragraph of the Treaty, the right to submit to the High Authority the observations of their members on the points for discussion.

Any such observations should reach the High Authority not later than Thursday, June 28, 1956.

DECISION concerning the replacement of a member of the Consultative Committee, now deceased

THE COUNCIL,

HAVING regard to Article 18, 2 and 3 of the Treaty ;

WHEREAS the Chambre Syndicale de la Sidérurgie Française, Paris, which was designated as a representative organization by decision of October 27, 1954, submitted through its President on April 30, 1956, in respect of the seat falling vacant following the death of M. Pierre Ricard on April 4, 1956, a list of two candidates, including M. Jacques Ferry, delegate-general of the Chamber Syndicale de la Sidérurgie Française and president and director-general of the Groupement de l'Industrie Sidérurgique ;

DECIDES :

That M. Jacques Ferry shall be appointed a member of the Consultative Committee (category producers) in succession to M. Pierre Ricard for the remainder of M. Ricard's term of office.

This decision was adopted by the Council at its thirty-second session on May 3, 1956.

M. Jacques Ferry wrote to the Secretariat of the Council on May 11, 1956, accepting the appointment.

THE HIGH AUTHORITY,

HAVING regard to Article 53, b of the Treaty ;

HAVING regard to Articles 65, 2 and 80 of the Treaty ;

HAVING regard to Decisions No. 14/55, of March 26, 1955, establishing financial arrangements to ensure a regular flow of scrap to the Common Market (*Official Gazette of the Community, March 30, 1955, p. 134*) No. 26/55, of July 20, 1955, concerning the steps whereby the financial arrangements to ensure a saving of scrap by the increased use of pig-iron were to be put into effect (*Official Gazette of the Community, July 26, 1955, p. 283*), and No. 3/56, of February 15, 1956, concerning the steps whereby the financial arrangements to ensure a saving of scrap were to be put into effect by the increased use of liquid basic Bessemer steel in electric furnaces (*Official Gazette of the Community, February 22, 1956, p. 16*) ;

HAVING regard to Decision No. 10/56, of March 7, 1956, extending the above decisions up to and including June 30, 1956 ;

WHEREAS it is apparent that the system at present in force calls for revision in the light of experience gained ;

WHEREAS it will not be possible to complete the detailed examination of a new system by June 30, 1956, and whereas it is therefore apparent that the aforementioned decisions must be further extended ;

with the unanimous agreement of the Council of Ministers.

DECIDES :

Article 1

Decisions No. 14/55, of March 26, 1955, No. 26/55, of July 20, 1955, and No. 3/56, of February 15, 1956, are hereby extended up to and including October 31, 1956.

Article 2

This decision shall come into force within the Community on July 1, 1956.

This decision was deliberated and adopted by the High Authority at its session on June 22, 1956.

DECISION No. 25/56, of June 27, 1956, concerning the collection during the financial year 1956-57 of the levies provided for in Articles 49 and 50 of the Treaty

THE HIGH AUTHORITY,

HAVING regard to Articles 49 and 50 of the Treaty.

HAVING regard to Article 78 of the Treaty ;

WHEREAS the Budget Estimates of the Community for the financial year 1956-57 were fixed on March 29, 1956, by the Committee set up under Article 78, 3 of the Treaty :

DECIDES :

Article 1

The levies provided for in Articles 49 and 50 of the Treaty shall be collected, in accordance with the conditions stated in the texts and decisions in force, up to the expiry of the financial year ending June 30, 1957.

Article 2

This decision shall come into force within the Community on July 1, 1956.

This decision was deliberated and adopted by the High Authority at its session on June 27, 1956.
