Subject: Legal status of EIB staff

Having regard to Article 130 of the EEC Treaty, does the Commission consider the European Investment Bank to be an institution of the Community?

If so, do the general provisions governing the European civil service, in particular the principle of the jurisdiction of the Court of Justice of the Communities in any dispute, apply to staff employed by the EIB?

Can the Commission state the legal, professional and trade-union guarantees enjoyed by EIB staff?

Is the Commission aware that the internal staff regulations of the EIB are confidential? Can this be justified in democratic institutions such as ours?

In the Commission's opinion, can the Court of Justice of the Communities claim jurisdiction on the basis of a confidential document?
