MOTION FOR A RESOLUTION

tabled by

Mr GLINNE, Mr VAN MIERT, Mr VAN MINNEN and Mr SARRE on behalf of the Socialist Group

pursuant to Rule 25 of the Rules of Procedure on the situation in Nicaragua

The European Parliament,

- deeply disturbed by the political situation in Nicaragua where a civil war is raging,
- 1. Condemns the dictatorial regime of President Somoza;
- Calls for the establishment of a democratic system in which respect for fundamental liberties and the rights of man will be ensured;
- 3. Gives its resolute support to the Sandinist Front as the authentic representative of the forces of democracy;
- 4. Accordingly, calls upon all the Governments
 - to freeze their diplomatic relations with the present regime,
 - to recognize the provisional Sandinist Government,
 - to suspend all economic, financial and military aid to the present regime;
- 5. Calls upon the Commission and the Member States to take a decision to grant food, medical and more generally humanitarian aid to the provisional Government and to the refugees;
- 6. Instructs its President to forward this reclution to the Commission and Council and the Governments of the Member States.
