## The European Parliament,

- A. Mindful of the need for human rights to be respected in all parts of the world,
- 1. Protests vigorously against the death sentence passed in the Soviet Union on the Belgian citizen, Jermak LUKJANOW, who had previously been detained for 15 years in a psychiatric hospital;
- Calls on the Conference of Foreign Ministers meeting in political cooperation to seek a suspension of the death sentence on Mr LUKJANOW and his immediate release;
- 3. Instructs its President to forward this resolution to the Conference of foreign Ministers meeting in political cooperation, the 10 governments of the Member States, the Council and the Commission.
